ORDER

12.06.2026 The petitioner named above apprehending her arrest in connection with Patepur PS Case no.-119/2026, u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352(2), 351(2), 3(5) of BNS and hence the instant petition for the grant of anticipatory bail has been filed on her behalf.

The prosecution case in short as per informant of this case namely Balram Singh is that on 05.03.2026 at 12:30 Manoj Singh, Shyam Singh, Mannu Kumari and Kamini Devi had assaulted him and his wife due to which they sustained head injury and hand injury. It is further alleged that Balram Singh received 15 stitches and his wife received 10 stitches. Accordingly, with the said allegation FIR has been instituted.

Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and she has committed no offence whatsoever as alleged. It is further submitted that

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petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to previous grudge and enmity. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties and case has been compromised between the parties and certified copy of compromise petition and permission is being filed with this bail petition. It is at last submitted that petitioner is ready to furnish sound and suitable sureties to the satisfaction of the court. It is therefore prayed that petitioner be admitted to anticipatory bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and submitted that allegation against accused/petitioner is of assaulting the informant and his wife due to which they sustained injury. It is therefore prayed to reject the bail application of petitioner.

From perusal of LCR and case diary it transpires that the allegation against accused/petitioner is of assaulting the informant and his wife due to which they sustained injury.

In the above facts, circumstances and also considering the fact that this is the case for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352(2), 351(2), 3(5) of BNS are bailable except offence u/s 109 of IPC. There is case and counter case bearing Patepur PS Case no. 118/2026. The injured Balram Singh has been examined at PHC, Patepur and only injury caused to injured Balram Singh is simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. Moreover the case has been compromised between the parties and accordingly compromise petition and permission petition has been

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filed on 09.03.2026. As such the accused/petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail in the event of her arrest or surrender within 30 days from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court below and also in the light of condition laid down u/s 482(2) of BNS.
