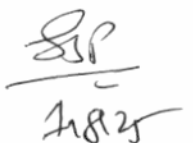
ORDER BELOW BAIL APPLICATION OF ACCUSED –
MOHD. SHABIR MOHD. SIDDIQUI IDRISI

1. The accused is arrested in above crime on 26.07.2025 and thereafter he is taken into MCR. On the same day, he has made present application for bail. Accused sought bail on the ground that, he is innocent and falsely implicated in this crime. Investigation is completed. Accused is permanent resident of Mumbai and having deep roots in the society. He shall co-operate with the investigation and ready to abide by any conditions, if imposed by the court.

2. Say of I.O. and APP was called. I.O. and Ld APP have filed their say and opposed the application on the ground that the weapon of offence i.e. blade is seized from the house of accused. The another weapon i.e. bamboo is yet to be recovered. Co-accused are yet to be arrested. The offence is non-bailable and cognizable. If accused is released on bail, he may abscond or tamper the prosecution evidence. They prayed for rejection.

4. Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused and Ld. APP at length.

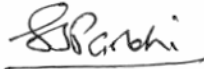
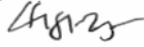
5. Having considered the facts of the case, nature of allegations and the seriousness of the offence, custodial interrogation is not required. Recovery of weapon and abscondance of accused cannot be a ground for rejection of bail application. The accused is a young boy of only 19 years of

age. So it is not desirable to keep him behind the bars for a long time. Specially when non of the offence is punishable with imprisonment of life or death. Liberty of a person is the constitutional right. Therefore, it is just and proper to release the accused on bail. Hence, following order :-

ORDER

- i) The application is allowed.
- ii) Accused be released on bail on his executing PB and SB of Rs.15,000/- or PB and CB of Rs. 15,000/-
- iii) The accused shall attend the concerned police station on every Tuesday & Thursday till filing of the final report.
- iv) The accused shall not contact the informant or any other prosecution witnesses in any manner.
- v) The accused shall not commit similar offence.
- vi) If any of the condition breached, then the bail will stand cancelled.
