Order

The petition on behalf of Lal Babu Rai has been filed and praying grant of regular bail to him.

The learned counsel for petitioner has submitted that the bail bond of petitioner was got cancelled for his non-appearance vide order dated 11.03.2022 and consequent thereupon the process of non bailable warrant of arrest was issued against him. It is submitted that no delay or latch has been committed by petitioner deliberately. It is further submitted that on 26.07.2022 the petitioner had surrendered before this court and prayed for bail but he was taken into custody with a direction to surrender the accused Chandan Kumar. It is further submitted that the said Chandan Kumar is in judicial custody since 02.07.2022 relating to case no. Hajipur Sadar PS Case no. 499/2022. It is further submitted that petitioner undertakes to remain present physically before court as and when required into the matter. It is, therefore, prayed that petitioner be allowed regular bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard the parties and perused the record. On the perusal of record it transpires that the bail bond of petitioner was got cancelled vide order dated 11.03.2022 and subsequent thereto the process of non-bailable warrant of arrest against him was issued by this court. The petitioner

is in custody since 26.07.2022. From the perusal of record it transpires that petitioner was admitted to bail by this court earlier and solitary instance of default is alleged to have been made which resulted into cancellation of his bail bond. It has been submitted that the default was not made deliberately and it has been undertaken that petitioner will remain physically present till final disposal of the case. It is, therefore, ordered that upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like nature the petitioner be admitted to regular bail. It is further directed that the bailors of petitioner shall be local persons having sufficient means and one of his bailor shall be his close relative.
