**ORDER**

Heard the petition filed on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Veena Devi u/s 227 of Cr.P.C. dated 16-08-2024. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that in this case, the case was instituted u/s 302/34 of I.P.C. and after investigation, charge-sheet has been submitted under aforesaid sections. He further submitted that during investigation no witness has named this petitioner, there is no any eye-witness, no independent witness has been examined, no specific allegation u/s 161 of Cr.P.C. during trial. The motive is also not given petitioner is not involve in this case and merely on basis of suspicion and being the relative he is falsely implicated.

On the other hand Ld. A.P.P. filed its rejoinder and stated that the F.I.R. is lodged in which petitioner is named as accused during investigation. The re-statement of informant the statement of Sulekha Devi, Nityanand Kumar, Bipin Kumar in para 20, 21 and 24 has named this petitioner as accused and as such the petition has no merit and same to be dismissed.

After hearing both the parties. Perused the case record. On perusal it is transpired that the petitioner is named in F.I.R. and during investigation her husband was arrested and he confess his guilt that he is brother Sudhir Kumar died in January 2023 and to grab his portion of land. He along with his wife Veena Devi started torturing his sister-in-law Sulekha Devi in which Raju Kumar Ranjan being the brother of Sulekha Devi interven and as such he along with his wife has a plan to kill the Raju

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Kumar Ranjan and in which lonely place. He fire upon the Raju on which he died. He fled away towards Kanchanpur where his wife was waiting. He handed over the pistol to his wife and fled away. In para 130 and 131 the witness Gita Devi and Rekha Devi has also stated that he seen the Gita Devi was fleeing away in accused Santosh Kumar. Hence, considering the facts and circumstances, material available on record. This court is of opinion that there is sufficient ground to proceed against this accused/petitioner and accordingly, the petition dated 16-08-2024 is hereby rejected.
