ORDER

The petitioner named above is in custody since 17.12.2024 in connection with Jurawanpur PS Case no.-151/2023, u/s 302/34 of IPC and hence the instant petition for the grant of regular bail has been filed on his behalf.

The prosecution case as per Fard-byan of informant Sunita Devi is that on 14.10.2023 at 09:00 PM at night, the informant's son Anshu Kumar was at his door, the moment on account of the road (pathway) dispute the accused persons Vishwanath Ram, Vindeshwar Ram, Ganesh Ram, Bablu Ram, Subodh Ram and Sunita Devi wife of Vishwanath Ram came at the door of the informant by being armed with lathi, danda and iron rod and started abusing him. That when the informant's son Anshu Kumar protested them not to abuse him then they started to beat him. Seeing this the informant and her husband Manoj Ram and her mother in-law Opindri Devi came to save him then all the accused started to assault them by lathi, danda and rod. That in the mean time the accused Vishwanath Ram hit the informant's husband on his head by iron rod and caused his head fractured and bleeding head injury and he fell down on the ground and became unconscious. On gathering of villagers the accused persons then fled away by

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threatening to kill them. The informant brought her husband to government hospital, Patepur from where he was referred to NMCH but seeing his serious condition he was then referred to PMCH, Patna but in course of the treatment he succumbed to injuries. Accordingly, with the said allegation FIR has been instituted.

Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that the petitioner is rotting in jail since 17.12.2024. It is further submitted that petitioner has filed Crl. Misc no. 85046/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna which was rejected on 09.01.2026. It is further submitted that petitioner is ready to furnish sound and local sureties to the satisfaction of court. It is therefore prayed that petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and submitted that the allegation against accused/petitioner is that he along with other accused persons assaulting informant, her son, husband and mother-in-law due to which they sustained injuries and the husband of informant died. The allegation against accused/petitioner is serious in nature. It is therefore prayed to reject the bail application of accused/petitioner.

Heard the parties and Perused the record. From perusal of LCR and Case diary it transpires that the accused/petitioner and other co-accused persons named in the FIR came at the place of occurrence laced with lathi, danda and iron rod assaulted the informant and other injured persons due to which the deceased Manoj Ram got fatal injuries and he died during his treatment at PMCH, Patna. The informant in his re-statement in para 4 and other witnesses in para 5, 6, 76 and 77 of the case diary have fully supported the prosecution case. Death Inquest report of deceased Manoj Ram is mentioned in para 8 of the case diary. The post-mortem report of deceased is mentioned

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in para 33 and 34 of the case diary which shows that the cause of death is due to cranio cerebral damage and its complications resulting from the injuries caused by hard and blunt object e.g lathi, danda, rod etc. The allegation against accused/petitioner is heinous in nature. The bail of accused/petitioner has been rejected earlier upto Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide Crl. Misc no. 85046/2025, dated 09.01.2026. Hence, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused/petitioner on regular bail and hence the bail application so filed on his behalf is hereby rejected.
