**ORDER**

**13.03.2026** The petitioners above named apprehending their arrest in connection with Bidupur PS Case No.- 613 of 2025, U/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 76, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS and hence instant petition for the grant of anticipatory bail has been filed on their behalf.

The prosecution case in short is that the informant of this case is Rekha Devi alleging that on 02.10.2025 at about 07:00 AM in the morning, her grandfather-in-law Vishnu Paswan, was brushing at door. There, Sumit Kumar,

Son of Chanbir Paswan, Village- Mathura, PS- Bidupur, Dist-Vaishali was waving a pistol and was threatening our grandfather-in-law, Seeing this, her cousin Lakshmi Devi, Wife of Bachcha Babu Paswan, said that why are you threatening her grandfather-in-law. On this Sumit Kumar, Himashu Kumar, Sudhanshu Kumar, Raghu Paswan, Rupesh Paswan @ Lalu Paswan, Mithilesh Kumar, Mannu Paswan, Sawan Kumar, Raj Kumar, Amarjeet Paswan, Chandrashekhar Paswan, Chanveer Paswan, Raghu Paswan, Chhotu Paswan, Chandeshwar Paswan's wife, Chanbir Paswan's wife, Raghu Paswan's wife, Chhotu Paswan's wife, Manju Devi, All of Village- Mathura they came and said that their son is a rangbaj. Who are you to say anything? If you say, then will kill you with this gun. When her gotni protest then all of them threw her gotni and assaulted her maternal uncle and father-in-law with bricks and beat them badly with sticks and caught her gotni by the hair and behaved badly and snatched nose ring of her younger mother-in-law Lalo Devi and hit her on the nose and face and threatened that sooner or later they will kill you all. It is further alleged that all of them are criminal minded people and can commit any unpleasant act any time and loss her life and property. Accordingly, with the said allegation FIR has been instituted.

Learned counsel for petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have committed no offence whatsoever as alleged. It is further submitted that no occurrence as alleged has taken place. It is further submitted that all the sections are bailable in nature except section 76, 303(2) of BNS. It is further

submitted that informant and the accused/petitioners are neighbours and there was only a hear say between the two parties regarding a dispute between the children. It is further submitted that accused/petitioners are ready to abide all the terms and conditions which are imposed upon them. It is further submitted that petitioners are law abiding citizen. It is therefore prayed that petitioners be admitted to anticipatory bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and submitted that the allegation against petitioners is of assaulting the family members of informant and also threatened them to kill her. As such they do not deserve to be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

From perusal of record it transpires that the allegation against petitioners is of assaulting the family members of informant and also threatened them to kill her.

In the above facts, circumstances and considering the fact that this is the case for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 76, 303, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS which are allailable except offence u/s 76, 303(2) of BNS. The informant as well as accused persons are neighbour and occurrence took place due to quarreling of children. Though the informant's fardbyan was recorded in Sadar Hospital but injury report has not been filed. There is vague and omnibus allegation that the accused persons snatched away nathuni of Lalu Devi. As such the accused/petitioners are ordered to be enlarge on bail in the event of their arrest

or surrender within 30 days from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/-  
each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court below  
and also in the light of condition laid down u/s 482(2) of BNS.
