This anticipatory bail application is preferred by petitioners namely 1. **Dhanmati Devi**, W/o.-Lalu Ram, aged about 32 years, 2. **Chanda Devi**, W/o.-Rajkumar Ram, aged about 35 years, 3. **Neha Devi**, W/o.-Sheshnath Ram, aged about 22 years, 4. **Munni Devi**, W/o.-Lalan Ram, aged about 32 years, all R/o. Village-Baakhari Bazar, P.S.-Gobardhana, District-West Champaran and 5. **Rani Devi @ Rani Kumari**, W/o.-Prabhu Ram, aged about 25 years, R/o.-Village-Banchahri, P.S.-Bagaha, District-West Champaran, apprehending arrest in connection with **Gobardhana P.S. Case No. 55/2025**, for the offences punishable under Sections-103(1), 61(2) of B.N.S.

PROSECUTION CASE

2. The prosecution case in brief is that on 03-11-202 around 11:00 P.M. informant's son namely Pintu Kumar after having dinner left his house. The informant had a dispute with his neighbours who are named accused person in this case. The informant has alleged that all named accused persons with common intention assaulted his son and killed him and then tied him on a tree and thereafter fled away.

SUBMISSION OF PETITIONERS

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that this is first bail application on behalf of these petitioners. No anticipatory or regular bail application has been filed earlier either before this Ld. Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners have no criminal antecedents. It is further submitted that petitioners are innocent, they have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case due to previous enmity and dirty village politics. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of these petitioners. There is no specific allegations against these petitioners. All petitioners are women On these grounds prayed for anticipatory bail.

SUBMISSIONS OF STATE

4. Ld. PP in-charge vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

DISCUSSIONS

5. Heard, perused the record. As per postmortem report there is ligature mark on the upper part of neck. Cause of death as per the opinion of Medical Officer, S.D.H., Bagaha is Asphyxia due to strangulation. The informant in the First Information Report itself has stated that petitioners had killed his son and his dead body was tied over a tree branch and thereafter the accused absconded. The witness at para No. 9 has supported the prosecution case. The investigation is going on and as per the opinion given in para-105 the police requested the court for issuance of process u/s-82 Cr.P.C. against the accused who have been found absconding from their residence. Even after several efforts the police has not been able to locate them.

6. Having regard to the gruesome nature of offence committed and stage of investigation, this is not a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail.

7. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **Rejected**.
