1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named petitioner, apprehending arrest in connection with **Complaint Case No.- 493/2025**, for the offences punishable under section- 115(2), 85 of BNS.

Prosecution case

2. The prosecution story in brief is that the complainant was first married to Rajat Jaiswal in 2020, but after his death during the corona pandemic, she was married to his brother in July 2023 following a proposal by his family and on payment of 10 lacs rupees by father of complainant for wedding expenses. After living together for some time on May 6, 2025 the accused persons conspired to demand an additional 3 lacs rupees and a Bullet motorcycle as dowry. When the complainant refused, claiming her father had already provided a motorcycle in her name, the accused allegedly tied her up and severely beat her with an intent to kill. She was reportedly saved by the intervention of neighbors and fled to her father's house, where a local panchayat was held.

Submissions of petitioner

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that no other anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of this accused either before this court or before any other higher court. The petitioner accused has no criminal antecedent. The petitioner never demanded any dowry, neither at the time of marriage nor thereafter. The petitioner accused has been falsely implicated in the aforesaid case due to land dispute. The allegation that the complainant was tied and brutally assaulted with intention to kill is baseless and false.

No medical document has been brought on record to support such a serious allegation. No injury report exists to corroborate the story of assault. The petitioner is ready and willing to keep the complainant with full dignity, honour and without any terms. & condition whatsoever. The alleged offences are based on matrimonial allegations and do not require custodial interrogation. The petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the court and investigation, if any. On these grounds prayed for privilege of anticipatory bail.

Submission of State

4. Learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Discussion

5. Heard and perused the case diary. The petitioner is the husband of the complainant and the issues are essentially matrimonial in nature. The accused appeared before the court and has given an undertaking to the effect that he will maintain his wife with full dignity and honour. He has also asserted that he will not misbehave and inflict cruelty on his wife. The wife Anju Devi also appeared before the court and stated that she is willing to live with her husband and give the matrimonial relationship to a chance flourish.

6. Having regard to the under taking, clean antecedent, no injury report and the nature of charge, a case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Result

7. Accordingly this anticipatory bail petition filed by above named petitioner is hereby **Allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within **30 days** from the date of communication of this order, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin with **following condition:**

- (i) One of the bailors shall be relative of the petitioner.
- (ii) Both the bailors shall provide their contact details- Mobile number, Whatsapp number, e-mail id (if available) **with an undertaking on affidavit** that these contact details shall not be changed till disposal of
