1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named petitioners, apprehending arrest in connection with **Ramnagar P.S Case No.- 16/2025**, for the offences punishable under section- 191(2), 193(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109(1), 74, 303(2), 351(2), 352 of BNS.

Prosecution case

2. The prosecution story in brief is that on 26.12.2020 at around 08:00 A.M. named accused persons armed with lathi, danda and lethal weapon came to the house of the informant and started to abuse her and broke the newly constructed wall. When the informant objected, Pintu Yadav caught her hair and assaulted her. Mukendra Yadav tore informant's clothes, When witness no. 1 came to rescue, Dipu assaulted him with farsa and when witness no. 2 came to rescue, then Nisha Kumari gave dab blow on her finger, witness no. 3 was assaulted by Jhunjhun Yadav. After that accused entered into the house of the informant and looted household articles and jewellery worth rupees 50,000/-

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that this is the first anticipatory bail petition, earlier no bail petition has been filed on behalf of these petitioners before this court or any other superior court. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent except petitioner no. 1 Mukendra Kumar who is accused in Tr. No. 47/2025, under section 427 of IPC. These petitioners are quite innocent and they have committed no offence. The petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case to save their neck from Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 596/2024 lodged by petitioners side. This case is the counter blast of the case lodged by petitioners. One accused named in F.I.R. Pintu Yadav has succumbed to injuries caused by informant side. In fact petitioners are real victims who have suffered injuries. On these grounds prayed for privilege of anticipatory bail.

Submission of State

4. Learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Discussion

5. Heard and perused the case diary. Previously Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 596/2024 was lodged by the petitioners against the informant side. The police after investigation submitted charge sheet under various sections except section 109 of BNS. However, the Magistrate has taken cognizance under section 109 of BNS and hence the petitioners are apprehending arrest. It is pertinent to mention that during the course of investigation the benefit of section 35(3) of BNSS was given to the petitioners and they have fully cooperated with the investigating agencies. Injury report is extracted at para no. 46 of the case diary. The Medical Officer at C.H.S. Ramnagar found the injuries on the person of Kirti Yadav, Anita Devi and Golu Kumar to be simple in nature caused by hard and blunt object. No criminal antecedents have been reported against the petitioners, except petitioner no. 1 .

7. Accordingly this anticipatory bail petition filed by above named petitioners is hereby **Allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within **30 days** from the date of communication of this order, the petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin with **following condition:**

- (i) One of the bailors shall be relative of the petitioners.
- (ii) Both the bailors shall provide their contact details- Mobile number, Whatsapp number, e-mail id (if available) **with an undertaking on affidavit** that these contact details shall not be changed till disposal of this case.
- (iii) Petitioners shall appear before the Ramnagar P.S. every fortnight till completion of the investigation and shall co-operate with the investigation.
- (iv) If any of the conditions are violated or facts stated in bail application are found false, the bail bonds of the petitioners shall be cancelled.
