1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named petitioners, apprehending arrest in connection with **Ramnagar P.S Case No.- 53/2026**, for the offences punishable under section- 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 74, 3(5) of BNS.

**Prosecution case**

2. The prosecution story in brief is that on 20.01.2026 at around 10:00 A.M. Jitendra Sah and his family members were digging the foundation near the land of the informant. When the informant objected then to big brother Rajendra Sah was called. Thereafter all named accused persons armed with lathi, danda and sharp weapons started to abuse and assault her. When her husband and son came to rescue then accused persons also assaulted them. Jitendra Sah tore her sari and blouse and she became naked. During scuffle accused persons took her gold mangalsutra worth rupees 70,000/-, gold chain worth rupees 40,000/- and cash of rupees 3000/- and 7000/- respectively from pocket of Ajay Kumar and her husband.

**Submissions of petitioners**

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that this is the first

anticipatory bail petition, earlier no bail petition has been filed on behalf of these petitioner before this court or any other superior court. All the F.I.R. named accused persons except and save petitioner no. 1 have no criminal antecedents. Case vide Ramnagar P.S. case No. 94/1998 was registered against petitioner no. 1 earlier in year 1998, which was disposed of and petitioner no. 1 was acquitted by the court. The petitioners are quite innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case due to ulterior motive and land dispute. The petitioner have not committed any offence as alleged in F.I.R. The petitioner Bhola Sah and his wife namely Radhika Devi are very old persons above 80 and 70 years. The petitioner no. 3,5,6 and 7 are ladies whose name are mentioned in written report by the informant to disturb the Family. In this case no sections 118(1), 109, 74 and 303(2) of BNS are applicable, no marpit had taken place and the allegation of theft is ornamental. Some altercation took place due to construction, which was stopped by the Jitendra Sah and informant went to police station. But Ramnagar police registered the case with false and concocted story as earlier Rajendra Prasad had filed a case against Ramnagar P.S. Prabhari which was registered on order of higher Police Authority, as Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 456/2025. Earlier to this case, Gayanti Devi had also filed a case vide Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 52/2026 against this informant. On these grounds prayed for privilege of anticipatory bail.

**Submission of State**

4. Learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

**Discussion**

5. Heard and perused the case diary. The petitioner no. 1 and petitioner no. 3 are aged about 81 years and 71 years respectively. As per para no. 36-55 there are no criminal antecedents recorded against the present petitioners, except petitioner no. 1 who has been acquitted of the charges. Injury report of Ajay Kumar is extracted at para no. 20 of the case diary. Medical Officer opined that the only injury found on the informant is an abrasion on the chest which is simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance.

W/o Dharmendra Sah has filed counter case vide Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 52/2026 against the informant. Witnesses at para no. 6,8 and 9 have stated that there are land dispute between the parties. Both the parties were involved in abusing and assaulting each other and both the parties were injured in the process.

6. Having regard to the nature of injuries caused, counter case, clean antecedent, pending land dispute between the parties, a case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

**Result**

7. Accordingly this anticipatory bail petition filed by above named petitioners is hereby **Allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within **30 days** from the date of communication of this order, the petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin with **following condition:**

(i) One of the bailors shall be relative of the petitioners.

(ii) Both the bailors shall provide their contact details- Mobile number, Whatsapp number, e-mail id (if available) **with an undertaking on affidavit** that these contact details shall not be changed till disposal of this case.

(iii) Petitioners shall appear before the Ramnagar P.S. every fortnight till completion of the investigation and shall co-operate with the investigation.

(iv) If any of the conditions are violated or facts stated in bail application are found false, the bail bonds of the petitioners shall be cancelled.
