**10.03.2026** Petitioners 1.Shivratan Yadav and 2.Guddi Devi apprehends their arrest in connection with Piparasi P.S. Case No.90/2025, u/s-126(2),115(2),118(2),352,3(5) BNS pending in the learned Court of Sri Anant Kumar, J.M. 1st Class, Bagaha and has filed the present anticipatory bail petition which has been pressed today. Copy of the same has been served to the learned P.P. In-charge for the State. Trial court record is available on record.

Sri Vinod Kumar, learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner and Sri Shamsul Hoda, learned I/c. P.P. In-charge for State are present before the Court.

The prosecution case in brief as narrated in the written application of informant namely Anita Devi is that on 20.10.2025 at about 12:00 p.m, all the accused persons named in FIR including petitioners armed with lathi, iron rod, Bakua and Dab arrived at her door and began erecting tat in her land. On objection raised by the informant, accused persons assaulted her by means of fats and fists. It has been further stated that Raksha Yadav assaulted informant by means of brick causing head injury due to which blood oozed and Vikash Yadav assaulted informant by means of Bakua causing cut injury on her left hand. Informant was rescued by the local people. On the basis of application of informant, present case was registered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that they are quite innocent and have committed no offence as alleged against them and have been falsely implicated in this case. Earlier no other bail application on behalf of the petitioners have been filed either before this court or any superior court. Petitioner Shivratan Yadav is also named in Piparasi P.S. Case No.59/23, while petitioner Guddi Devi has got no criminal antecedent. It has been further submitted that petitioner Shivratan Yadav is own father-in-law of the informant. It has been further submitted that there is land dispute between the parties. It has been further submitted that there is no specific allegation against the petitioners. It has been further submitted that as per injury report of informant, all the injuries are simple caused by hard and blunt object. Other co-accused persons have been granted bail by this Court. Offences leveled against the petitioners are not applicable. Hence, they may kindly be allowed bail.

On the other hand learned I/c. P.P. In-charge for State vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioners.

Heard both sides and perused the F.I.R., case diary and injury report. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners rather there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. Land dispute between the parties is admitted in FIR itself. As per injury report, injury of informant is simple caused by hard and blunt object.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and material available on record as discussed above, petitioner in event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of one month from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s-438(2) Cr.P.C.
