1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named petitioners, apprehending arrest in connection with **Ramnagar P.S. Case No.- 470/2025, Tr. No. 3358/2025** for the offences punishable under section- 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.

**Prosecution case**

2. The prosecution story in brief is that on 26.07.2025 at around 7:00 P.M. informant went to collect his money from the named accused persons, he had earlier given money 10,000/- rupees to Sudama, When he demanded his money back, he and his family members started misbehaving and told him to come the next day. When he again went to ask for his money, Sudama's sons were present. Instead of returning the money, they started abusing him. Soon after, Vishal and Vikas came along with others, they assaulted him with lathi and rods and attempted to kill him. During the incident, they also snatched his gold chain and ring, and forcibly took rupees 5,000/- from him, all accused persons hit on his head due to which his head got fracture.

**Submissions of petitioners**

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that earlier no anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners

either before this court or Hon'ble High Court Patna and Hon'ble High Court against the order dated 10.12.2025 by which Court below was pleased to take cognizance against the aforesaid accused petitioners. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent. The petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no such offence as alleged against them. All offences are bailable in nature save and except section 109(1) of BNS which is super addition. On 16.09.2025 petitioner accused namely 1. Sudama Sah, 2. Vishal, 3. Bittu Sah, 4. Godawari Devi and 5. Pintu Sah surrendered before Court below of Bagaha on 16.09.2025 and they were enlarged on bail after furnishing of 5000/- of two sureties of like amount each as per the order of the Court below. After investigation, police submitted charge-sheet bearing charge-sheet No. 1196/2025 against all the accused persons named in the FIR under section 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. Accordingly cognizance was taken on 10.12.2025 and summon was order to be issued against all the accused persons, which has been duly served upon them. After receiving the summon issued by the court it transpired that police submitted charge sheet u/s 109 (1) of BNS. Perusal of FIR it reveals that there is no intention or knowledge to kill the informant rather entire allegation is vague, general and omnibus not specific against any of the above named accused persons. It is a settled principle of law the once bail granted is always granted. On these grounds prayed for privilege of anticipatory bail.

**Submission of State**

4. Learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

**Discussion**

5. Heard and perused the record. As per para no. 51 of the case diary one swelling on the left forearm and two lacerated wound on the middle head and over forehead were found on the person of Chhote Sah. According to the doctor the injuries are simple in nature as the C.T. scan of the brain was not submitted. Omnibus allegations have been made against the present petitioners, no specific overt acts

have been assigned to any of the accused. Earlier FIR was instituted under section 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS and on that basis the petitioners were granted bail by the Court below on 16.09.2025 on furnishing of bail bond of rupees 5000/- and two sureties of like amount each. However the charge sheet came to be submitted in aforesaid sections including section 109 (1) of BNS. Further the cognizance has also been taken under the same sections as mentioned in the charge sheet.

6. Having regard to the nature of the injuries caused, clean antecedent and omnibus allegations, a case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

**Result**

7. Accordingly this anticipatory bail petition filed by above named petitioner is hereby **Allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within **30 days** from the date of communication of this order, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin with **following conditions**:

(i) One of the bailor shall be close relative of the petitioners.

(ii) Both the bailors shall provide their contact details- Mobile number/ Whatsapp number, e-mail id (if available) **with an undertaking on affidavit** that these contact details shall not be changed till disposal of this case.

(iii) If any of the conditions are violated or facts stated in bail application are found to be false, the bail bonds of the petitioner shall be cancelled.
