1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named petitioners, apprehending arrest in connection with **Ramnagar P.S Case No.- 51/2026**, for the offences punishable under section- 191(2), 191(3), 190, 127(2), 115(2), 109(1), 351(2), 352, 74, 132, 121(1), 121(2) of BNS.

**Prosecution case**

2. The prosecution story in brief is that on 16.01.2026 informant was on duty police dial 112 along with police force, he reached to the house of Jitendra Prasad Bari. When he reached to the house of Chandev Kumar at about 2:05 P.M. he got information that Jitendra Bari's daughter Pooja Kumari got married with Chandan Kumar son of Saral Bari and they inflicted cruelty on her. Informant saw both the parties assaulting each other. Informant informed to the Senior Officer and appealed to both parties to go the police station, 10-15 people and petitioner became aggressive and attacked the police force using lathi, danda and iron rod. They also misbehaved with the female police force and engaged in obscene acts and an attempt was made to snatch informant's pistol. They attacked the informant with a sharp weapon made of iron, but he narrowly escaped and they also behaved indecently and made obscene gestures towards female police

**Submissions of petitioners**

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that this is the first anticipatory bail petition, earlier no bail petition has been filed on behalf of these petitioners before this court or any other superior court. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent except petitioner no. 4 Prahlad Prasad vide Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 150/2017 under section 323, 341, 324, 504, 34 of IPC. These petitioners are quite innocent and they have committed no offence. All the sections are bailable except 109(1), 74, 132 BNS which are not applicable against petitioners accused because they did not commit the offence of attempt to murder and the allegation of 132 BNS is also false and fabricated because they did not assault or use criminal force against police force and also did not commit the offence under section 74 BNS because they did not commit assault or use criminal force against female police personnel with the intent to outrage her modesty. There are no eye witnesses who has seen the petitioners on the place of occurrence, only mere suspicion petitioners name has been disclosed in the aforesaid case. On these grounds prayed for privilege of anticipatory bail.

**Submission of State**

4. Learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

**Discussion**

5. Heard and perused the case diary. General and omnibus allegation have been made against the petitioners. No specific overt acts have been attributed to any of them. Injury reports are extracted in para no. 1-33 of the case diary wherein it is mentioned that A.S.I. Sanjay Bhagat, Sipahi Swaminath Singh, Siphari Kusum Kumari, Vivek Ranjan have received injuries which are simple in nature caused by hard and blunt object. Witnesses at para no. 3-5 are official witnesses and interested in the out come of the case. No life threatening injuries have been found on the person of the police

**6.** Having regard to the nature of injuries found by the doctor, non recording of statements of independent witnesses and general and omnibus allegations, a case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

**Result**

**7.** Accordingly this anticipatory bail petition filed by above named petitioners is hereby **Allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within **30 days** from the date of communication of this order, the petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin with **following condition:**

- (i)** One of the bailors shall be relative of the petitioners.
- (ii)** Both the bailors shall provide their contact details- Mobile number, Whatsapp number, e-mail id (if available) **with an undertaking on affidavit** that these contact details shall not be changed till disposal of this case.
- (iii)** Petitioners shall appear before the Ramnagar P.S. every fortnight till completion of the investigation and shall co-operate with the investigation.
- (iv)** If any of the conditions are violated or facts stated in bail application are found false, the bail bonds of the petitioners shall be cancelled.
