1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named petitioners, apprehending arrest in connection with **Naurangiya P.S Case No.- 109/2025**, for the offences punishable under section- 115(2), 127(2), 303(2), 308(2) 352, 351 3(5) of BNS.

Prosecution case

2. The prosecution story in brief is that on 28.09.2025 at around 8:00 AM all named accused reached at the informant Nitesh Kumar's house, armed with deadly lethal weapons in their hands entered into the house and assaulted him. He made a video on his mobile phone of the assault. They went away waving their weapons and saying they will not be saved after this and threatened to kill his family members. On the same day they reached their house and committed assault on family members in his absence and warned

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them to leave the house otherwise be ready to face dangerous consequences. Further they stated that they were extortionist and they live on extorted money and demanded six lacs rupees. After that Navin Kumar who is brother of informant filed a Complaint case no. 814/2025. He stated that again they all trespassed and started beating and assaulting his family members and went away with boxes having clothes, cash and jewellery. Jai Prakash Shukla snatched a gold ring worth 35,000/- rupees from his pocket forcefully and Bhuneshwar Shukla snatched mobile phone from his hand when he was filming the video.

Submissions of petitioners

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that no other bail application has been filed earlier on behalf of these accused either before this court or before Hon'ble High Court. The petitioners accused have no criminal antecedent except **1. Naurangiya P.S. Case No. 41/2019, u/s 323, 341, 379 of IPC 2. Naurangiya P.S. Case No. 43/2025, u/s 127(2), 115(20, 118(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS and 3. Naurangiya P.S. Case No. 144/2025, u/s 308(5), 303(2), 115(2), 352, 351(30, 3(5) of BNS.** Further submitted that the petitioners accused are quite innocent and have not committed any offence. All the alleged offences are bailable except section 308(2) and 303(2) of BNS which is not applicable in this case against petitioners. Entire prosecution case is maliciously false, baseless and concocted merely as a counter blast of Naurangiya P.S. Case No. 110/2025 filed by the one of the petitioner accused namely Bhuneshwar Kumar Shukla against the informant and his family members. The petitioners accused and informant both are pattidar and land disputes are pending between both the parties. Due to this the present false case has been hatched up by the informant. On these grounds prayed for privilege of anticipatory bail.

Submission of State

4. Learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

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Continued Discussion
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5. Heard and perused the case diary, it transpires that the one of the petitioner Bhuneshwar Kumar Shukla has filed counter case vide Naurangiya P.S. Case No. 110/2025 against informant and his family members. Both the accused and informant are pattidar and there is land dispute between the parties. No specific overt acts have been attributed against any of the petitioners. Also There is no delivery of property to suggest extortion. Further there is no recovery any kind of money from the possession of the petitioners. Although, there is an allegation of beating, injury report at para no. 25 shows no external injury was caused to informant- Nitesh Kumar. Also the charge under section 308(20 BNS has been dropped by the police. There is no mention in the case diary with regard to the video footage captured or the seizure of mobile phone.
6. Having regard to the nature of allegations, cross case and pendency of land dispute between the parties, a case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Result

7. Accordingly this anticipatory bail petition filed by above named petitioners is hereby **Allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within **30 days** from the date of communication of this order, the petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin with **following condition:**

- (i) One of the bailors shall be relative of the petitioners.
- (ii) Both the bailors shall provide their contact details- Mobile number, Whatsapp number, e-mail id (if available) **with an undertaking on affidavit** that these contact details shall not be changed till disposal of this case.
- (iii) Petitioners shall remain physically present on each and every date before Ld. Court *in seisin* till framing of charge and failure to appear on two consecutive dates shall lead to cancellation of bail.
- (iv) That if any of the conditions are violated or facts stated in bail

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Continued application are found false, the bail bonds of the petitioners shall be
