J.M. 1st Class, Bagaha and have filed the present anticipatory bail petition which
has been pressed today. Copy of the same has been served to the learned P.P In-
charge for the state.

Sri Shailesh Kumar Tiwari, learned Counsel for the petitioners and Sri
Shamshul Hoda Ansari, learned P.P. In-charge for State assisted by Sri
C.B. Tripathi learned counsel on behalf of the informant are present before the
Court.

The prosecution case in brief as narrated in the written application of the
informant namely Kishnawati Devi is that on 28.01.2026 at about 08:30 a.m, all
the accused persons named in FIR including petitioner assaulted Subhash Sahani
who is informant's father by means of lathi-danda, farsa and foot and fists causing
injuries on his arm, eye and chest. It has been stated that accused persons
assaulted the informant's father till he became unconscious. Due to the assault of
accused persons, Subhash Sahani sustained injury on his eye and also fracture
injury on his shoulder. On the basis of application of the informant, present case
was registered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they are quite
innocent and have committed no offence as alleged against them and have been
falsely implicated in this case. Earlier no other bail application on behalf of the
petitioners has been filed either before this court or any superior court. Petitioners
have got no criminal antecedent excepting petitioners no. 3 and 6 against whom
Piprasi P.S. Case No. 50/2017 is pending. It has been submitted that allegation
against the petitioners is not specific rather it is general and omnibus against all
the accused persons. Land dispute between the parties is admitted in FIR itself.
There is case and counter case between the parties. Injury of Subhash Sahani has
been opined to be grievous which is due to fracture of the upper third of right
humerus bone which is not vital part of the body. Offences leveled against the
petitioners are not applicable. Hence, they may kindly be granted privilege of
anticipatory bail.

16.03.2026 On the other hand learned P.P In-charge for state assisted by learned counsel on behalf of the informant vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioners with other co-accused persons assaulted Subhash Sahani causing injury on his eye and shoulder. Injury of Subhash Sahani has been opined to be grievous which is due to the fracture of upper third of right humerus bone. In view of nature and gravity of offence, petitioners do not deserve anticipatory bail.

Heard the parties and perused the case diary and injury report. Land dispute between the parties is admitted in FIR itself. There is case and counter case between the parties due to land dispute. Allegation of assault against the petitioners is not specific rather it is general and omnibus against all the accused persons.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and material available on record as discussed above petitioners in event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of one month from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 438(2) Cr.P.C **with further conditions as follows:-**

1. Petitioners will not indulge themselves in any illegal activities in future

2. and also they will not threat or tamper witnesses.

3. Petitioners will co-operate in investigation and trial.

In case of non compliance of the above conditions, their bail bond may be cancelled by the learned Court below on the instance of Prosecution.
