**1.** This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named petitioner, apprehending arrest in connection with **Valmikinagar P.S Case No.- 15/2026**, for the offences punishable under section- 103, 3(5) of BNS.

**Prosecution case**

**2.** The prosecution story in brief is that on 19.01.2026 Budhai Miyan was going to deliver buffaloes to an acquaintance in Nepal. Budhai Miya had sold buffaloes to Sadhu Yadav and his close friend Shyam was also with him. The buffaloes had to be transported to the Chul Batha river bank through the forest, As the buffaloes became violent, Budhai Miya called husband of the informant, Chhotelal Kushwaha, Sohan Kushwaha and Dilip Dhagad for taking them away. Next day the buffaloes were found tied near the Radhakrishna temple. Budhai Miyan fled to Nepal via the river, Chhotelal, Sohan and Dilip returned home via forest, but husband of informant went missing.

**Submissions of petitioners**

**3.** Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that this is the first bail petition being moved by this petitioner. It is further submitted that this petitioner is quite innocent and he has committed no offence. This petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. From perusal the FIR itself, it is quite clear that deceased engaged (himself) in illegal trade of animals. This case has been instituted on mere on conjecture and surmise. On these grounds prayed for privilege of anticipatory bail.

**Discussion**

Heard and perused the case diary, Post mortem report is extricated at para no. 52 of the case diary wherein the cause of death is opined to be asphyxia as a result of ante-mortem drawing Witnesses at para no. 5 to 13 have supported the prosecution case. The deceased was last seen along with the petitioner. Investigation is still going on At para no. 34 of the case diary, Shri Shakil Alam has stated that petitioner along with the deceased had gone to the forest and he had seen them in the light of torch at Chohatta Ghat and on seeing him the accused and the deceased fled away from the seen of occurrence.

6. Having regard to the nature of offence committed by the accused and the stage of investigation, this case is not fit case for grant of anticipatory bail.

**Result**

7. Accordingly this anticipatory bail petition filed by above named petitioner is hereby **Rejected**.
