16.05.2006 1. This anticipatory bail application is preferred by petitioners namely **1. Zamil Ansari @ Zamil Mian**, S/o-Late Fardin Ansari @ Fardin Mian, **2. Harun Ansari**, S/o-Zamil Ansari, **3. Balal Ansari** S/o-Zamil Ansari, **4. Ekram Ansari** S/o-Zamil Ansari and **5. Jhunna Ansari @ Jhunna Ansari** S/o-Harun Ansari. All R/o-Village-Mathiya, P.S.-Ramnagar, District-West Champaran, apprehending arrest in connection with **Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 65/2026**, for the offences punishable under Sections-126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 329(3), 3(5) of B.N.S.

PROSECUTION CASE

2. The prosecution case in brief is that on 26-01-2026 around 8:00 A.M., informant was present at her house, in the meantime named accused along with two unknown armed with iron rods, Farsa, and Garasa came there. Jameel Ansari ordered to kill her, upon which all the accused brutally assaulted her with the intention to kill by pressing her neck with their legs. On hulla, both her sons and son-in-law came to rescue her. Haroon Ansari and Bilal Ansari assaulted with iron rods intending to kill, striking on the heads of her sons. Ekram Ansari attacked her younger son Shahbaz Khan with a sharp weapon, causing severe head injuries. Jhunnu Ansari assaulted her son-in-law Sajid Khan with an iron rod. While trying to defend himself, the thumb of his left hand got fractured. It is also alleged that Jhunnu Ansari snatched her gold chain worth Rs. 30,000/- from her neck. Local people took them to the Government Hospital, Ramnagar,

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from where they were referred to Bettiah for better treatment.

SUBMISSION OF PETITIONERS

 **3.** Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that this is first bail application on behalf of these petitioners. No anticipatory or regular bail application has been filed earlier either before this Ld. Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners have no criminal antecedents. It is further submitted that petitioners are innocent, they have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. The offence u/s-303(2) B.N.S. is ornamental, offence u/s-118(1) B.N.S. is not applicable because injured persons have not sustained sharp cut injury and the offence u/s-109 B.N.S. is also not made out as there is no intention to kill the informant and injured persons. A compromise petition has been filed on behalf of both the parties stating therein that the case has been compromised between the parties and they do not wish to pursue the case any, further. On these grounds prayed for anticipatory bail.

SUBMISSIONS OF STATE

4. Ld. P.P in-charge opposed the prayer for bail, however submitted that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

DISCUSSIONS

5. Heard, perused the record. As per para-25 of the case diary there are no criminal antecedents against the present petitioner. The injury reports of Shahbaj Khan, Sahid Khan, Sahit Khan, Aslam Khan and Rubya Khatoon are extracted at para No. 14 of the case diary, wherein simple injuries are opined to have been caused by hard and blunt object. On some persons no external

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injures have been found. There is counter-case vide Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 87/2026 filed by the petitioners against the informant party. The injured persons along with informant appeared before the court and stated that they have settled the issues and do not wish to pursue the matter any further.

6. Having regard to the nature of injuries caused, cross case, no criminal antecedents and settlement of issues between the parties, in considered view of this Court, a case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

7. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **Allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within **30 days** from the date of communication of this order, the petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin with **following condition:**

(i) One of the bailors shall be relative of the petitioners.

(ii) Petitioners shall remain physically present on each and every date before Ld. Court *in seisin* till framing of charge and shall not be physically absent on three consecutive dates till disposal of this case.

(iii) Petitioners shall seek no adjournment, but for sufficient reasons.

(iv) Petitioners as well as bailors of the petitioners shall submit their complete address, mobile number/whatsapp number, e-mail-address (if available) with undertaking on affidavit that they would not change the same without prior permission of the Court till disposal of the case.

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(v) If any of the conditions are violated or facts stated in bail application are found false, the bail bonds of the petitioners shall be cancelled.
