01.04.2026 A bail application earlier filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Rajan Chaudhary under judicial custody since 10.01.2026 in connection with Bagaha P.S. Case No.11/2021, u/s-392 IPC pending in the learned Court of the A.C.J.M. 1st, Bagaha has been pressed today. Copy of the same has been served to the learned P.P. In-charge for State. Trial Court record is available on record.

Sri Upadhyay Sunil Kumar, learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner and Sri Prabhu Prasad, learned P.P. In-charge for State are present before the Court.

The prosecution case in brief as narrated in the written application of informant namely Dharmendra Kumar is that he works as Sangam Manager in Bharat Finance. On 05.01.2021, he was returning to Bagaha branch from Patilar after collection of Rs.1,83,797/- in the meantime at about 02:50 p.m, two persons on a motorcycle overtook him near Petrol Pump of Kailash Baitha and threatened to kill him and took out his bag from dikki of his bike containing Rs.1,83,797/-, Samsung Tab and his mobile phone. On the basis of application of informant, present case was registered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged against him and has been falsely implicated in this case. Earlier no other bail application on behalf of the petitioner has been filed either before this Court or any superior Court. Petitioner is also named in eleven other criminal cases as 1).Bagaha P.S. Case No.112/12, 2).Bhairoganj P.S. Case No.38/15, 3).Yogapatii (Sanichari O.P.) P.S. Case No.490/21, 4).Patkhauri P.S. Case No.218/21, 5).Bhairoganj P.S. Case No.491/21, 6).Valmikinagar P.S. Case No.61/20, 7).Valmikinagar P.S. Case No.48/21, 8).Bagaha P.S. Case No.518/21, 9).Semra (Chiutaha) P.S. Case No.95/21, 10).Semra P.S. Case No.101/21 and 11).Yogapatti P.S. Case No.275/15. It has been submitted that petitioner is not named in FIR rather his name was revealed in course of investigation. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is under judicial custody since 10.01.2026. Hence, he may kindly be enlarged on bail.

On the other hand learned P.P In-charge for state vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner and submitted that petitioner along with other co-accused persons have committed loot of Rs.1,83,797/- and petitioner has long criminal antecedent. In view of nature and gravity of offence, he does not deserve bail.

01.04.2026 Heard both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of the same, it transpires that there is allegation against the petitioner and other co-accused persons to commit loot of Rs.1,83,797/- and other electronic gadgets of the informant in broad day light by threatening to kill him. Name of the petitioner was revealed in course of investigation in this case. The confessional statement of the petitioner also shows his involvement in the case and petitioner have eleven criminal antecedent. Investigation is still pending against the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and material available on record as discussed above coupled with long criminal antecedent, this Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner accused on bail. Accordingly prayer for bail of the petitioner is hereby **rejected**.
