10.04.2026 A bail application earlier filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Amirullah Khan under judicial custody since 27.02.2026 in connection with Cyber Bagaha P.S.Case No.03/2026, u/s-318(4),3(5) BNS & 66(C),66(D) I.T.Act pending in the learned Court of the ACJM-II Bagaha has been pressed today. Copy of the same has been served to the learned P.P In-charge for state.

Sri Kamran Aziz, learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner and Sri Prabhu Prasad, learned P.P In-charge for state are present before the Court.

The prosecution case in brief as narrated in self statement of Anuj Kumar, Inspector, Cyber Police Station Bagaha is that on the basis of information received from Cyber Crime Special Unit Patna and complains registered on NCRP Portal regarding Cyber fraud against the account of Amirullah Khan, a raid was conducted by SHO Chautarwa at his house situated at Kolhuwa Chautarwa and several passbooks and ATM cards in the name of Amirullah Khan and Jahan Ara Khatoon were recovered. When Amirullah Khan was questioned, he revealed that he got opened several bank accounts in different banks in his name as well as in the name of his wife on the instance of his neighbour Shahidur Rahman. It was also revealed by Amirullah Khan that he used to withdraw money from his account to handover the same to Shahidur Rahman and used to get Rs.1000/- daily for each of the accounts. On the basis of application of informant, present case was registered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged against him and has been falsely implicated in this case. Earlier no other bail application on behalf of the petitioner has been filed either before this court or any superior court. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. It has been submitted there is no mentioning about the transaction of money from the petitioner's account. Passbooks and ATM cards recovered from the house of the petitioner belongs to him and his wife. It has been also submitted that co-accused Shahidur Rahman is next door neighbour of the petitioner and he misused the bank passbooks and ATM Cards of the petitioner as well as his wife. Offences leveled against the petitioner are not applicable. Hence, he may kindly be allowed bail.

On the other hand learned P.P In-charge for state vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner and submitted that petitioner has got opened several bank accounts in his name as well as in the name of his wife for commission of Cyber fraud as explicit from Seizure List. Confessional statement of the petitioner accused is also there in case diary in which has disclosed his indulgence in the alleged occurrence. In view of above, he does not deserve bail.

Heard the parties and perused the case diary. Petitioner is named in FIR. Several Passbooks and ATM cards issued in the name of the petitioner as well as in the name of his wife have been recovered from the house of the petitioner which is explicit from seizure list. As per paragraph no.07 of case diary, several complains have been found registered on NCRP portal against the different accounts of the petitioner accused. Confessional statement of the petitioner accused is also there in case dairy. Investigation of the case is still pending.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and material available on record as discussed above, this Court is not inclined to enlarge petitioner accused on bail. Accordingly prayer for bail of the petitioner is hereby **rejected**.
