**19.03.2026** A bail application earlier filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Sandeep Ram under judicial custody since 09.03.2026 in connection with Semra P.S.Case No.126/2025, u/s-137(2),96 BNS pending in the learned Court of Sri Rajeev Shankar, J.M.1st Class, Bagaha has been pressed today. Copy of the same has been served to the learned P.P In-charge for state.

Sri Kamran Aziz, learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner and Sri Prabhu Prasad, learned P.P In-charge for state assisted by Sri Abdul Majeed, learned counsel on behalf of the informant are present before the Court.

The prosecution case in brief as narrated in the written application of the informant namely Chunchun Devi is that on 14.12.2025 at about 02:00 p.m, Sandeep Ram entered her house and took away her minor daughter with intention of marriage after persuading her when she was busy in irrigating her wheat crop. When informant went to the house of Sandeep Ram and asked about her daughter, they abused her. On the basis of application of the informant, present case was registered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged against him and has been falsely implicated in this case. Earlier no other bail application on behalf of the petitioner has been filed either before this court or any superior court. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. It has been submitted that alleged occurrence took place on 14.12.2025 while FIR was lodged on 24.12.2025 after delay of 10 days. It has been submitted that petitioner and the victim are next door neighbour. Victim was in love with the petitioner and she went with the petitioner on her won will. It has been further submitted that good sense between the parties has been prevailed and they are ready to solemnize marriage of the petitioner with the victim as soon as she gets the age of majority. Hence, he may kindly be allowed bail.

Learned P.P In-charge for state assisted by learned counsel on behalf of the informant has submitted that inter-se dispute between the informant and the petitioner who allegedly took away informant's daughter with intention of marriage, has been amicably resolved.

Heard the parties and perused the record. Informant and victim are present before the Court and they have stated that amicable relation between the parties has been established. Petitioner is under jail custody since 09.03.2026.

**19.03.2026** Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and material available on record as discussed above, petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below.
