16.05.2006 1. This anticipatory bail application is preferred by petitioners namely **1. Sahid Shekh @ Sahid Khan**, S/o-Abulesh Shekh @ Abulesh Khan, aged about 25 years, **2. Arbaj Shekh**, S/o-Abulesh Shekh, aged about 23 years, **3. Abulesh Shekh** S/o-Nejahabul Shekh, aged about 55 years, **4. Jubaid Shekh @ Jubair Shekh** S/o-Kalim Shekh, aged about 23 years, **5. Ashalam Shekh** S/o-Nejahabul Shekh, aged about 32 years, **6. Sabana Khatoon** W/o-Boga Shekh, aged about 35 years and **7. Sajid Shekh @ Sajid Khan** S/o-Guasuddin Khan, aged about 27 years, All R/o-Village-Meghawal Mathia Ward No. 12, P.S.-Ramnagar, District-West Champaran, apprehending arrest in connection with **Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 65/2026**, for the offences punishable under Sections-126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 117(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S.

PROSECUTION CASE

2. The prosecution case in brief is that on 26-01-2026 around 7:30 A.M., a dispute arose in Meghwal Mathiya Ward No. 12, Ramnagar, West Champaran, when neighbour of informant namely Abulesh Sheikh started beating his 6-year-old Golu Kumar without reason. When Golu's father, Balal Ansari, objected, FIR named accused started abusing him, and attacked him. Shahid Sheikh struck Balal Ansari on the head with an iron rod with intent to kill, causing serious bleeding injuries. When Haroon Ansari tried to intervene, Arbaaz Sheikh assaulted him with *Lathi* and fractured both of his hands, while Sajid Sheikh injured his head. When Haroon's son Jhuna Ansari came to rescue them,

Sabana Khatoon assaulted him with *Lathi* and fractured his right hand. The accused also threatened to kill them if they filed a case. On hulla, nearby people intervened and took the injured persons to P.H.C, Ramnagar, from where they were referred to GMCH Bettiah. Due to the critical condition of Balal Ansari, he was further referred to Patna for better treatment.

3. Though Learned Advocate for the petitioners has not given certificate in para-2 in the manner as prescribed by the Hon'ble Court and failed to mention whether this is first bail application or second bail application. Nonetheless from the statement made in para-2 it appears that this is the first bail application. This mistake of Advocate should not be sole ground for rejection of prayer for anticipatory bail. Hence, the matter was taken up for hearing and disposal. The petitioners have no criminal antecedents. It is further submitted that petitioners are innocent, have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty politics and ill will. All alleged sections are bailable in nature except section 109(1) B.N.S. which is only added to make this case serious and non-bailable. One of the petitioners has filed a case vide Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 62/2026 against the informant and his family members and this case is counter version of the same. The case has been filed with a compromise petition attached with this bail application. On these grounds prayed for anticipatory bail.

4. Ld. P.P in-charge opposed the prayer for bail, however submitted that the matter has been compromised between the

DISCUSSIONS

5. Heard, perused the record. As per para-17 of the case diary there are no criminal antecedents against the present petitioners. The injuries reports of Jhunna Ansari, Balal Ansari and Harun Ansari are extracted at para No. 21 of the case diary. The doctor has opined the injuries on Jhunna Ansari to have been caused by hard and blunt substance. The injury caused to Balal Ansari have considered to be grievous in nature but the said injury is on non-vital part of body i.e. on hand. Only one abrasion and swelling is caused to Harun Ansari, which according to the doctor is grievous in nature but is on the non-vital part of body. There is counter-case vide Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 62/2026 filed by the petitioners' side against the informant party. The injured persons along with informant appeared before the court and stated that they have settled the issue and do not wish to pursue the matter any further.



6. Having regard to the nature of injuries caused, citus of injury, clean antecedents, counter-case and settlement of issues between the parties, in considered view of this Court, a case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

7. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **Allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within **30 days** from the date of communication of this order, the petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin with **following condition:**

(i) One of the bailors shall be relative of the petitioners.

(ii) Petitioners shall remain physically present on each and every date before Ld. Court *in seisin* till framing of charge and shall not be physically absent on three consecutive dates till disposal of this case.

(iii) Petitioners shall seek no adjournment, but for sufficient reasons.

(iv) Petitioners as well as bailors of the petitioners shall submit their complete address, mobile number/whatsapp number, e-mail-address (if available) with undertaking on affidavit that they would not change the same without prior permission of the Court till disposal of the case.

(v) If any of the conditions are violated or facts stated in bail application are found false, the bail bonds of the petitioners shall be cancelled.
