 No. 75/2026 registered u/s-126(2),115(2),109(1),351(2),117(2),3(5) BNS pending
 in the learned Court of the ACJM-I Bagaha and have filed the present anticipatory
 bail petition which has been pressed today. Copy of the same has been served to
 the learned P.P In-charge for the state. Case diary is available on record.

Sri Sunil Kumar Mishra, learned Counsel for the petitioners and Sri
 Prabhu Prasad, learned P.P.In-charge for State assisted by Sri Sanjay Dev Pati
 Tiwari, learned counsel on behalf of the informant are present before the Court.

The prosecution case in brief as narrated in the written application of the
 informant Singhasan Ram is that on 01.03.2026 at about 10:00 p.m, all the
 accused persons who are his agnate and also named in FIR having steel rod, lathi,
Khanti obstructed the road of the informant and also poured sewage water on his
 grand son Durgesh Kumar which caused etching on his body. When informant
 inquired about the alleged incident to the accused persons, they abused him and
 one Nanhu Ram assaulted him by means of *Khanti* causing head injury due to
 which he fell down on the ground. When Chunnu Ram and Premshila Devi came
 to rescue the informant, Dinesh Ram assaulted Chunnu Ram by means of *Khanti*
 causing head injury due to which blood oozed. Further Dinesh Ram assaulted
 Premshila Devi also by means of *Khanti* causing fracture of her hand. When local
 people arrived there, accused persons threatened the informant and his family
 members and fled away. On the basis of application of the informant, present case
 was registered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they are quite
 innocent and have committed no offence as alleged against them and have been
 falsely implicated in this case. Earlier no other bail application on behalf of the
 petitioners has been filed either before this court or any superior court. Petitioners
 have got no criminal antecedent. It been submitted that petitioners are the
 informant are agnate and there is land dispute between them as admitted in FIR
 itself. There is case and counter case between the parties. Injury of the informant
 and Chunnu Ram is simple caused by hard and blunt object. Injury of Premshila
 Devi has been opined to be grievous which has been caused due to fracture of

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30.03.2026 both radius and ulna bone. Offences leveled against the petitioners are not applicable. Hence, they may kindly be granted anticipatory bail.

On the other hand learned P.P In-charge for state assisted by learned counsel on behalf of the informant vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioners and submitted that there is specific allegation against the petitioner 7.Dinesh Ram to assault Chunnu Ram and Premshila Devi by means of Khanti causing injury to them. Further there is specific allegation against the petitioner 9.Nanhu Ram to assault the informant by means of Khanti causing head injury. Other petitioners abused and threatened the informant and his family members. In view of above, they do not deserve privilege of anticipatory bail.

Heard the parties and perused the case diary with injury report. There is specific allegation against the petitioners 7.Dinesh Ram to assault Chunnu Ram and Premshila Devi by means of Khanti causing injury to them. Further there is specific allegation against the petitioner 9.Nanhu Ram to assault the informant by means of Khanti causing head injury. Allegation against other petitioners is to abuse and threaten the informant and other injured persons. Injury of the informant and Chunnu Ram is simple caused by hard and blunt object. Injury of Premshila Devi has been opined to be greivous which has been caused due to fracture of both radius and ulna bone. Petitioners and the informant are agnate and there is land dispute between them as admitted in FIR. There is case and counter case between the parties.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and material available on record as discussed above coupled with specific allegation of assault against the petitioner 7.Dinesh Ram and 9.Nanhu Ram, this court is not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners **7.Dinesh Ram** and **9.Nanhu Ram** is hereby **rejected**.

So far prayer for anticipatory bail of other petitioners 1.Vikash Ram 2.Nibha Devi 3.Seema Devi 4.Madhu Devi 5.Ramlal Ram 6.Umesh Ram 8.Anita Devi 10.Vidhayanchal Ram is concerned, there is no allegation of assault against these petitioners.

In view of above, petitioners 1.Vikash Ram 2.Nibha Devi 3.Seema Devi 4.Madhu Devi 5.Ramlal Ram 6.Umesh Ram 8.Anita Devi 10.Vidhayanchal Ram in event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of one month from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s-438(2) Cr.P.C.
