23.04.2026 Petitioners 1.Amina Khatoon, 2.Ali Salam Shah, 3.Robabjala Khatoon and 4.Chaini Khatoon apprehend their arrest in connection with Chautarwa P.S. Case No. 321/2025 registered u/s-190,191(2),191(3),126(2),115(2),109, 303(2),74,329(4),352,351(2) BNS pending in the learned Court of the ACJM-I, Bagaha and have filed the present anticipatory bail petition which has been pressed today. Copy of the same has been served to the learned P.P In-charge for the state.

Sri Kamran Aziz, learned Counsel for the petitioners and Sri Prabhu Prasad, learned P.P.In-charge for State assisted by Sri Nihal Ranjan Shukla, learned counsel on behalf of the informant are present before the Court.

The prosecution case in brief as narrated in the written application of the informant Nasrin Khatoon is that on 15.11.2025 at about 06:00, all the accused persons named in FIR came at the informant's house and abused her. On objection raised by the informant, Lal Sah assaulted her by means of sharp edged farsa causing head injury due to which she sustained injury. Thereafter all the accused persons entered the house of the informant and assaulted her. One Ali Salam Sah pulled the informant on the ground and Amina Khatoon took out her jewellery in course of assault. Allegedly accused persons also threatened the informant to kill her. On the basis of application of informant, present case was registered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they are quite innocent and have committed no offence as alleged against them and have been falsely implicated in this case. Earlier no other bail application on behalf of the petitioners has been filed either before this court or any superior court. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedent of similar nature. It has been submitted that petitioners are next door neighbours of the informant. Injury of the informant is simple caused by hard and blunt object. Allegation of assault by means of farsa is specifically against Lal Sah who is not petitioner here. There is no specific allegation of assault against these petitioners. Moreover, inter-se dispute between the parties has been amicably settled. Hence, petitioners may kindly be granted privilege of anticipatory bail.

Learned P.P In-charge for state assisted by learned counsel on behalf of the informant conceded that inter-se dispute between the parties has been amicably resolved.

Heard the parties and perused the case diary alongwith injury report. There is no specific allegation of assault against these petitioners rather it is specifically against Lal Sah who is not petitioner. As per injury report of the informant, a single injury has been found on head which is simple caused by hard and blunt substance. Informant appearing before the Court has stated that inter-se dispute between them has been settled.

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23.04.2026 Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and material available on record as discussed above, petitioners in event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of one month from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 438(2) Cr.P.C
