**13.04.2026** Petitioner 1.Dilip Kumar alias Dilip Patel apprehends his arrest in connection with Ramnagar P.S.Case No. 349/2024, Tr.No.2252/2025 registered u/s-303(2),317(2),3(5) BNS pending in the learned Court of the SDJM Bagaha and has filed the present anticipatory bail petition which has been pressed today. Copy of the same has been served to the learned P.P In-charge for the state.

Sri Upadhyay Sunil Kumar, learned Counsel for the petitioner and Sri Prabhu Prasad, learned P.P.In-charge for State are present before the Court.

The prosecution case in brief as narrated in the written application of the informant namely Ratnesh Kumar Paswan is that he parked his motorcycle bearing registration no.BR22AP0249 near Shiv Temple Ramnagar and went to talk with his friend, in the meantime two persons came there and took away his motorcycle from there. Informant ran after accused persons, but they escaped. On the basis of written application of Ratnesh Paswan, present case was registered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged against him and has been falsely implicated in this case. Earlier no other bail application on behalf of the petitioner has been filed either before this court or any superior court. Petitioner is also named in Ramnagar P.S.Case No.126/2023. It has been further submitted that petitioner is not named in F.I.R rather his name was disclosed in the course of investigation in confessional statement of co-accused Anuranjan Sharma alias Rahul Shamra. Stolen motorcycle has not been recovered from the possession of the petitioner rather it has been recovered from the house of Dilshan Ansari. Petitioner is 21 year young student having no indulgence in the alleged occurrence. Petitioner was also not identified in CCTV footage. Excepting confessional statement of co-accused persons, there is no material against the petitioner in case diary. Co-accused Anuranjan Sharma alias Rahul Sharma and Lalbabu Chauhan have already been granted regular bail by BP No.1121/2024 and B.P.No.1016/2024 respectively. Hence, he may kindly be granted privilege of anticipatory bail.

On the other hand learned P.P In-charge for state vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard the parties and perused the F.I.R and case diary. Petitioner is not named in F.I.R rather his name was disclosed in the course of investigation in confessional statement of co-accused Anuranjan Sharma alias Rahul Shamra. Stolen motorcycle has not been recovered from the possession of the petitioner rather it has been recovered from the house of co-accused Dilshan Ansari. Co-accused Anuranjan Sharma alias Rahul Sharma and Lalbabu Chauhan have already been granted bail by BP No.1121/2024 and B.P.No.1016/2024 respectively. Petitioner is 21 years old.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and material available on record as discussed above, petitioner in event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of one month from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like

**13.04.2026** amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 438(2) Cr.P.C with further condition that petitioner shall remain physically present on each date till framing of charge and his absence on three consecutive dates without plausible reason, his bail bond will be cancelled by the learned Court below.
