25.03.2026 Petitioners 1 Nawal Bin 2. Bnuari Devi 3. Lalbabu Bin 4. Deva Bin 5. Nagendra Bin. are apprehending their arrest in connection with Naurangiya P.S. Case No. 75/2025 u/s 96, 137(2), 303(2), 351,3(5) of the BNS which is pending in the court of ACJM 2nd Bagaha and have filed the present petition for anticipatory bail.

Heard Mr. Mirtunjay Kumar Singh the learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Addl. P.P. for the state.

The case of the prosecution in brief is that one Rukhsana Khatoon made petition before SHO Naurangiya alleging therein that day of 18.07.2025 at about 3 AM above named petitioner having common intention conspired to induced his daughter namely Shahina Begum to solemnized marriage and forcefully kidnapped her and she is minor and with intention to theft they stole 60,000/- and ornament of 1,50,000/-

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners are quite innocent and they have committed no offence as alleged. This is the first bail application being moved by these petitioner and no other bail application has been filed to any court. Petitioner no. 01 and 05 has two criminal antecedent is which he is on bail. 1. Naurangiya PS 03/26 u/s 30(a), 30(c) excise Act & 27 Arms Act 2. naurangiya P.S. 04/26 u/s 27 Arms Act. While other petitioners bears no criminal antecedent. Entire allegations are false, fabricated and concocted which are far beyond truth and actual state of affair. That they have been falsely implicated in this case due to love affair between Shahin and Deva. That these petitioners neither kidnapped the victim nor they induce her to getting marriage. That these petitioner did not procure the victim to any one. That no offence is made out at all against these petitioners. Victim is residing with his husband namely Deva and victim is not minor.. Petitioners undertake to co-operate in early disposal of the case. Hence, they may kindly be granted anticipatory bail.

On the other hand learned Addl. P.P vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioners and submitted that petitioners have committed offence, so these petitioners do not desersve for privilege of anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the FIR and LCR. It transpires that the petitioners are alleged to have enticed away the minor daughter of the informant on the pretext of marriage. Petitioner no. 4 is stated to be the main accused in the case, where as no specific allegation has been attributed against petitioner Nos. 1,2,3 and 5. Further, as per para no. 3 of the bail petition, Petitioner Nos. 1 and 5 are reporeted to have two criminal antecedents each and other petitioners bears no criminal antecedent. Therefore, in this situation, I do not find it a fit case to give the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner no. 4 namely **Deva Bin S/o Nawal Bin**, Accordingly his prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby **rejected**.

So far, Allegation against the petitioners no. 1. Nawal Bin 2. Bnuari Devi 3. Lalbabu Bin and 5 Nagendra Bin is not specific, rather it is general and omnibus.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and material available on record and discussed above, petitioners no.1. nawal Bin 2. Bnuari Devi 3. Lalbabu Bin and 5. nagendra Bin in event of their arrest or surrender before the learned lower court within a period of one month from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order is directed to be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482 (2) BNSS.
