25.03.2026 Petitioners 1.Anil Kushwaha and 2.Tufani Kushwaha @ Tuphani Bhagat apprehends their arrest in connection with Piprasi P.S. Case No.30/2026, u/s-126(2),115(2),118(1),109(1),74,76,303(2),352,3(5) BNS pending in the learned Court of Sri Anant Kumar, J.M. 1st Class, Bagaha and has filed the present anticipatory bail petition which has been pressed today. Copy of the same has been served to the learned P.P. In-charge for State.

Sri Sanjay Kumar, learned counsel on behalf of the petitioners and Sri Prabhu Prasad, learned P.P. In-charge for State are present before the Court.

The prosecution case in brief as narrated in the written application of the informant namely Munna Ansari is that on 17.02.2026 at about 07:00 p.m, he was selling chicken meat at his shop at Manjhariya ward No.6 Piprasi in the meantime all the accused persons named in FIR including the petitioners came there and abused him and also started throwing items of his shop. On objection raised by the informant, Dhananjay Kushwaha assaulted the informant by means of knife causing head injury due to which blood oozed. When Amina Khatoon came to rescue the informant, accused persons caught hold her and assaulted her due to which her Samij was torn. It has been further stated that Dhananjay Kushwaha took out Rs.7000/- from the informant's shop and Mintu Kushwaha took out Mangalsutra of Amina Khatoon in course of assault. On the basis of application of the informant, present case was registered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they are quite innocent and have committed no offence as alleged against them and have been falsely implicated in this case. Earlier no other bail application on behalf of the petitioners has been filed either before this court or any superior court. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. It has been submitted that petitioners and the informant are neighbours and good sense between them has prevailed. There is case and counter case between the parties. Certified copy of joint compromise petition filed on behalf of the informant, which was also filed before the learned Court below. Hence, they may kindly be allowed bail.

Learned P.P. In-charge for State assisted by learned counsel on behalf of the informant has conceded that inter-se dispute between the parties has been amicably resolved.

Heard the parties and perused the F.I.R. There is case and counter case between the parties. Both the parties appeared before the Court and stated that dispute between the parties has been amicably resolved and certified copy of joint compromise petition filed on behalf of the informant before the learned Court below has been filed. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the informant has no objection on point of bail of the petitioners.

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25.03.2026 Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and material available on record as discussed above, petitioners in event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of one month from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 438(2) Cr.P.C.
