1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named petitioner, apprehending arrest in connection with **Complaint Case No.- 560/2024., Tr. No. 2088/2025**, for the offences punishable under section- 323, 341, 498(A) IPC, 3 & 4 Dowry Prohibition Act.

Prosecution case

2. The prosecution story in brief is that on 04.06.2021 the complainant got married with the petitioner Bablu Kumar and her father gifted clothes, ornaments, furniture, motorcycle and other utensils worth rupees eight lakhs to the petitioner and after marriage she went to her matrimonial house. Under conspiracy accused/petitioner started to demand rupees three lakh as dowry for doing business and petitioner used to beat her and also lock her in a room keep her hungry and thirsty, committed torture on her. Thereafter her father reached there along with witnesses and panchayat took place. She has a baby child. Again they brutally assaulted her and also gave threat of solemnizing second marriage of the petitioner. On 13.06.2024 all accused persons together tried to strangulate her and sprayed kerosene oil on her body. They snatched all her ornaments and threw her out of the house.

Submissions of petitioner

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that no other anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of this accused either before this court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner accused has no criminal antecedent. The petitioner accused is falsely implicated in aforesaid case with an ulterior motive by the complainant. The petitioner accused is quite innocent and has

Continued not committed any offence as alleged by the complainant. The entire
18-04-2026 allegation of dowry demand and torture is false and fabricated and there is no truth in it. This false case has been brought to vex victimize and harass. It is the complainant who is playing to the tune of her maika and does not want to live in the house of petitioner and she is putting pressure upon the petitioner to settle at her maik. When the petitioner refused to do so, complainant went to her maik and to pressurising. She lodged this false complaint case. The petitioner is ready and willing to keep the complainant with full dignity and to provide her all facility as per his capacity, but it is the complainant who does not want to live with the petitioner in his house. On these grounds prayed for privilege of anticipatory bail.

Submission of State

4. Learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Discussion

5. Heard and perused the case diary. The petitioner is the husband of the complainant. Both parties appeared before the court and stated that they want to settle their disputes. The wife is ready to accept the offer of the petitioner of monthly expenses of rupees 4,000/-. The petitioner has given an undertaking to this effect and also asserted that he will abide by the terms and conditions set by the court.

Anticipatory bail petition of the in-laws of the complainant has been granted by the then Sessions Judge in A.B.P. No. 689-C/2024 vide order dated 20.01.2025. The issue is essentially matrimonial in nature, confined to the husband and wife. These two parties have expressed their willingness to work out on the relationship and the petitioner has also assured that he will pay the agreed amount of rupees 4,000/- per month in the account of the complainant.

6. Having regard to the undertaking, clean antecedent and willingness to keep his wife with full dignity, a case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

7. Accordingly this anticipatory bail petition filed by above named petitioner is hereby **Allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within **30 days** from the date of communication of this order, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin with **following condition:**

(i) One of the bailors shall be relative of the petitioner.
(ii) Both the bailors shall provide their contact details- Mobile number/ Whatsapp number, e-mail id (if available) **with an undertaking on affidavit** that these contact details shall not be changed till disposal of this case.

(iii) Petitioner shall remain physically present on each and every date before Ld. Court and shall not be absent on three consecutive dates till disposal of the case.

(iv) If any of the conditions are violated or facts stated in bail application are found false, the bail bonds of the petitioner shall be cancelled.
