1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named petitioners, apprehending arrest in connection with **Complaint Case No.- 158/2025, Trial No. 2113/2025**, for the offences punishable under section- 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 303(2), 55, 85, 352, 351(2) of BNS.

Prosecution case

2. The prosecution story in brief is that on 19.06.2024 complainant was married with Kanai Baroi according to Hindu customs. After some days all the petitioners went to West Bengal with complainant and lived there happily. Later on all the accused persons misbehaved with the complainant for dowry of rupees 13,00,000/-. On refusal, she was confined to the room by her husband and one Deepak Baroi tried to burn her by sprinkling petrol and forced her to starve. The complainant informed her father. On 06.09.2024 all the accused persons ousted her from West Bengal after assaulting and snatching her articles. The complainant came back to her maik by train, accused followed her and assaulted her on Railway Station Chowk and threatened to being the dowry amount.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that this is the first anticipatory bail petition, earlier no bail petition has been filed on behalf of these petitioner before this court or any other superior court. The petitioners have no criminal antecedents. These petitioners are quite innocent and they have committed no offence as alleged in the complaint. The petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioners apprehend their arrest by the police in this false case, hence anticipatory bail application is being filed. The petitioners are respectable persons in their society and there is no question of their absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. The petitioner Deepak Baroi is a government servant, living mostly outside and he has deliberately been implicated to get him removed from his service. The entire story is inherently improbable and as much as it is stated that all the accused persons came from West Bengal to Bagaha Station Chowk for causing cruelty and demand dowry. On these grounds prayed for privilege of anticipatory bail.

Submission of State

4. Learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Discussion

5. Heard and perused the case diary. The petitioners are husband and relatives of the husband of the complainant. General and omnibus allegations have been made against them. Sandhya Devi, who is the complainant in the present case appeared before the court along with her husband Kanai Baroi and stated that the parties have settled the matter and settlement petition has been drawn on 25.02.2026. Both the parties affirmed their signature on the settlement petition and recorded the contents of the said document. The present case is essentially a matrimonial matter and no criminal antecedents are recorded against the petitioners.

6. Having regard to the nature of issues involved, the settlement and clean antecedents, a case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

7. Accordingly this anticipatory bail petition filed by above named petitioners is hereby **Allowed**. In the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within **30 days** from the date of communication of this order, the petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin with **following condition:**

- (i) One of the bailors shall be relative of the petitioners.
- (ii) Both the bailors shall provide their contact details- Mobile number, Whatsapp number, e-mail id (if available) **with an undertaking on affidavit** that these contact details shall not be changed till disposal of this case.
- (iii) If any of the conditions are violated or facts stated in bail application are found false, the bail bonds of the petitioners shall be cancelled.
