S. after the word “a” and before the word "moment" existing word“ingle” be deleted and on this place “Single” be added.</p> <p>A rejoinder on behalf of the plaintiff against the petition of amendment dated 01-05-2024 filed by the defendant 1st party is as Follows:-</p> <p>That petition under reference is quite mala-fide and vexatious and not at all maintainable either in the eyes of law and on facts and it is fit to be rejected.</p> <p>That defendants have got no right to file the amendment petition.
