In view of the compromise pursis and an application to set-aside the order of conviction vide **Exh:16 & 17 respectively**, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and they do not wish to proceed further with the matter. ORDER

- II. The order of conviction, fine and compensation passed by learned 11th Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vadodara, against the 1present appellant in **CC No.22333/2022** is hereby **quashed and set aside**.
- III. The appellant **Deepsinh B. Solanki** is hereby acquitted from the charges levelled against his in this case.
- IV. The bail bond of the appellant accused are hereby cancelled.
- V. The copy of this order and R & P, if any, be sent back to the concerned learned trial Court.
