It is submitted by AR for the complainant that civil liability against the accused has been settled.

It is submitted by the accused that he want to plead guilty with further submission to take lenient view against him as he has already made payment of the impugned bill.

Accused is duly warned about the legal consequences of his plea of guilt and he has been informed that he may be convicted on the basis of his plea of guilt. He has been given time to think over again and to consult his counsel but he has insisted to plead guilty to the offence committed by him.

After making necessary enquiry from the accused, the court is satisfied that the accused has voluntarily pleaded guilty to the offence committed by him.

It is prayed by accused that benefit of Probation Act be given to him and he be released on probation.

Separate statement of AR for the complainant regarding civil liability recorded.

Separate statement of accused regarding plea of guilt towards criminal liability is also recorded.

So far as, criminal liability is concerned the accused has already pleaded guilty as per the statement made today, hence, **accused is held guilty for the offence u/s 135 of electricity Act.**

Let notice be issued to the SHO concerned for filing report regarding previous conviction/ involvement report of the accused and report from the concerned Probation officer be also called for the next date of hearing.
