ORDER

1. Applicant / Accused Reshabh Raizada is seeking permission to travel to Thailand during the period 27.04.2025 to 02.05.2025 to attend a wedding and releasing of his passport. Applicant wishes to join the said wedding as the same is being organized by his close family friend.
2. On behalf of CBI, Ld. Prosecutor has submitted that the prosecution evidence is going on in the matter and the absence of accused would delay the proceedings.
3. I have given due consideration to the issue in hand.

4. The applicant was arrested during the investigation, although he has been granted regular bail.

5. Applicant has furnished the copy of wedding card, details of travel itinerary and has also furnished the copy of air-tickets and hotel bookings.

6. In view of the facts and circumstances and nature of journey, the application of the applicant/accused Reshabh Raizada is allowed. Let the passport of the applicant be released to him and he is permitted to travel to Thailand during the period 27.04.2025 to 02.05.2025 subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) That the applicant/accused will furnish a personal bond of Rs.2,00,000/- along with one surety of same amount. It is subject to the condition that in case applicant/accused fails to comply with terms and conditions of this order, the security amount shall be liable to be forfeited.
- (ii) He shall furnish security in the sum of Rs.2 lacs in the form of FDR in the name of the Court.
- (iii) The applicant/accused Reshabh Raizada shall personally appear before this Court on his return from abroad within three days of his return and shall surrender his passport.

- (iv) He shall not dispute his identity during the recording of his evidence in his absence.
- (v) In any eventuality, accused will not request for extension for staying abroad.
- (vi) The permission by the Court will not be construed as any direction to any authority and applicant/accused may visit Thailand for the above mentioned period, subject to applicable law/rules.

The application is accordingly disposed off.
