

BA3048 of 2018 Harjit Singh Vs State of Punjab

1. This is anticipatory bail application moved by accused/applicant Harjit Singh in case FIR No.103 of 1.11.2018, under Sections, 419, 420,465,467,468,471,511,20-B IPC registered at P.S. Fatehgarh Churian.
2. Notice of bail application was given to State.
3. Sh. Bhupinder Sharma APP for the State put his appearance.
4. Record has been called.
5. Arguments heard.
6. Contention of Mr. H.S.Janjua Advocate counsel for applicant/accused is that applicant/accused is being falsely implicated in the present case. He argued that case is pertaining to grant of loan in the name of Puran Singh. Applicant/accused who is revenue Patwari has no role to play. Jamabandi has been given in the name of Puran Singh, actual owner. Jamabandi is computer generated and the same is being supplied by a special department created under Revenue Land Society which is being run in a Fard Kendara. His contention is that there are no allegation against applicant/accused with regard to any conspiracy. His contention is that documentary evidence is involved and custodial interrogation of

accused/applicant is not required. He further argued that applicant/accused is ready to join investigation and fully cooperate with the Investigating Agency.

7. Adjourned to 3.12.2018

8. In the meantime applicant/accused is directed to join investigation and cooperate with the IO. In the event of arrest of applicant/accused, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of IO/Arresting Officer, subject to conditions laid down Under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
