2. Ld APP orally contested the bail application and a prayer is made for dismissal of the same.

3. Heard on the bail application moved by accused/applicant Gurpreet Singh @ gopi. Perusal of record reveals that accused/applicant is booked in the instant case for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 406 and 420 of IPC and allegations against the accused are very serious in nature in this case. Thus, there is every likelihood of absconding the accused from trial of the case in case he is released on bail and he may also temper with the evidence. As such in view of my above discussion and keeping in view the peculiar facts of the case and seriousness of allegations against the accused/applicant, accused/applicant **Gurpreet Singh @ gopi** is not entitled to be released on bail, so his bail application is hereby dismissed.
