

State Vs. Rajan Bhuggania
(FIR No. 77 of 2025, PS Kheri Gandian)

Vide this order, the Court shall dispose of an application 12.11.2025 filed by applicant/ accused Rajan Bhuggania through counsel for grant of bail.

2. It is submitted in the application that applicant/ accused has not committed any offence. He is an innocent person. The police of PS Kheri Gandian has involved the applicant/ accused in a false case. The applicant/ accused was arrested on 14.09.2025 and since then he is in custody. The applicant/ accused is no more required by the police for further investigation. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take sufficient long time and till then the custody of the applicant/ accused is uncalled for. The applicant/ accused is ready to furnish the bail bonds / surety bonds as per the satisfaction of the Court. Hence, a prayer for releasing the accused / applicants on bail has been made.

3. On the other hand, learned Addl.P.P for the State filed reply to the application and submitted that application is not maintainable. The present case was registered on the statement of complainant Gurpreet Singh with the allegations that complainant Gurpreet Singh is running a factory of Cement, Pipe & Pillar at Baghora Road, Bahawalpur. On 02.08.2025 at about 8:00 PM, he came back to his house in routine manner after completing his work and the labour was doing rest in labour room. On 03.08.2025 at about 2:00 AM, 15/20 persons armed with iron rods and swords forcibly entered into the factory and they covered their face with cloth. They locked the labour in a room. They stolen Iron Rod weighing 18 quintal, Iron rings weighing 12 quintal and iron channels weighing 2 quintal by way of loading the same in Vehicle No. PB1-JQ-6753. The accused is also involved in case FIR No. 141 dated 06.09.2025, U/s. 127 (2), 331 (4), 305, 324 (4), 190 BNS 2023, PS Pasiana. As such, applicant/ accuse is not entitled for concession of bail and prayed for the dismissal of the bail application.

4. I have heard Ld. Counsel for the applicant/ accused and Ld. APP

for the State and have gone through the record carefully.

5. The present FIR initially registered against unknown persons with the allegations that on 03.08.2025 at about 2:00 AM, 15/20 persons armed with iron rods and swords forcibly entered into the factory and they covered their face with cloth. They locked the labour in a room and stolen Iron Rod weighing 18 quintal, Iron rings weighing 12 quintal and iron channels weighing 2 quintal by way of loading the same in Vehicle No. PB1-JQ-6753. Later on, applicant/ accused was arrested in FIR No. 141 dated 06.09.2025, U/s. 127 (2), 331 (4), 305, 324 (4), 190 BNS 2023, PS Pasiana and they admitted the theft committed in the present case. Considering, the FIR was registered against unknown persons and the accused is named on the basis of his confessional statement, the allegations leveled against the applicant/ accused are yet to stand the test of trial. The perusal of remand papers shows that applicant/ accused Rajan Bhuggania was arrested by the police on 01.10.2025 and since then, he is in custody. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicant/ accused. The presentation of challan and thereafter conclusion of Trial would take long time and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant/ accused in custody for indefinite period. Thus, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, the applicant/ accused namely Rajan Bhuggania is admitted to bail in the present case under Sections 238, 305, 331 (6) BNS, on his furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.80,000/- with one surety of the like amount, subject to following conditions:-

- 1) The applicant shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing.
- 2) The applicant shall not interfere in the investigation or indulge themselves in influencing or threatening the witnesses.
- 3) The applicant shall not leave the territory of India without the prior permission of the Court.

Application disposed of accordingly. Requisite Bail bonds/ surety bonds not furnished. Papers be tagged with remand papers.
