ORDER:

1. Record received. Heard. It is mentioned in the instant bail application that applicant/accused has not committed any offence and has been falsely implicated in the present case by the police of P.S.Longowal. It is further averred that applicant is old aged lady of 81 years and

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suffering from number of ailment and has no concern with the alleged occurrence. It is further averred that complainant has nominated the applicant on the grudge of family of applicant. It is further averred that police of P.S.Longowal raided the house of applicant and applicant has apprehension in her mind that above said officials will arrest the applicant and torture her. It is further averred that custodial interrogation of accused/applicant is not required and nothing is to be recovered from applicant. It is further averred that applicant is ready to join the investigation as and when required by the police and the applicant undertakes to abide each and every terms and conditions imposed by the Court while granting the bail. Hence, it is prayed that bail application may kindly be allowed.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused while arguing in the lines of bail application contended that same may be allowed.

3. Conversely, learned Addl.P.P. for the State assisted by learned counsel for complainant contended that there are serious allegations against the accused/applicant and therefore, bail application may be dismissed.

4. After hearing rival submissions, it has transpired that instant case FIR was registered on the statement of one Gurlal Singh that he is agriculturist and on 11.09.2024, at about 8:00 A.M. , he along with his father Sukhdev Singh, mother Sukhpal Kaur were at home and then his

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mother Sukhpal Kaur was standing near the gate and their neighbour Sajjan Singh, Gurdial Kaur and Jasvir Singh were standing in the street. Jasvir Singh was spilling the water, which got accumulated in front of house of Gurlal Singh. Sukhpal Kaur objected to it and then Sajjan Singh, Jasvir and Gurdial Kaur abused her and after some time Sajjan Singh and his grandsons Lovepreet Singh and Jaspreet Singh holding iron rod, Jasvir Singh and Gurdial Kaur (accused/applicant) holding sticks by raising lalkara entered the house of Gurlal Singh and then Lovpreet Singh hit Sukhdev Singh (father of complainant) with iron rod on his head and Lovpreet Singh also hit Gurlal Singh (complainant) with iron rod on his left leg and his leg got fractured. Jaspreet Singh then hit complainant with iron rod on his right leg, which also got broken and all accused attacked them with their respective weapons, kick and fist blows. On hearing noise, cousin of complainant namely Jasvir Singh and others came there and the assailants ran away from the spot and injured were taken to hospital. On recording this statement, police machinery swung into action and instant case FIR was registered.

6. Aforesaid allegations reveal that accused persons by forming unlawful assembly brutally attacked complainant and his family by forcibly entering their house and therefore keeping in view the gravity of allegations, no exceptional ground is made out to extend the concession of anticipatory bail to accused/applicant. Resultantly, instant bail

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application is ordered to be dismissed. Record be returned. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
