At this stage, Ld. Counsel for complainant has submitted that concerned witness with regard to the bank account of the deceased has been examined. Therefore, it is further submitted that bank account of the deceased was freezed by the IO during investigation. It is further submitted that the said account is not required for any further proceedings for conclusion of the trial. Therefore, the said account may be de-freezed accordingly.

Ld. Addl.PP is asked to submit accordingly in this regard. Ld. Concerned bank manager is directed accordingly. Copy of order be given dasti to the counsel for complainant.
