On inquiry, IO submits that the documents of Vikas Kumar, Ashok Sharma, Devender, Deepak and and Ankit Kumar Singh were recovered from the possession of accused Manjay Kumar and Vikas. Out of them, accused Ankit Kumar Singh could not be traced, however, remaining four accused persons were contacted and interrogated. They were not found involved in the present case and they have been cited as witnesses.

On further inquiry, IO submits that though, NBWs were secured against accused Manoj Pradhan, who is the source of recovered contraband but application for issuance of process U/s 84 BNSS, 2023 qua him was dismissed by this Court in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi titled as Lakshay Jaiswal Vs. NCT of Delhi & Anr., Crl. MC no. 3952/2024, Crl. MA no. 15075/2024 and Crl. MA 15076/2024 decided on 18.07.2024.

On further inquiry, IO submits that he has not challenged the said order but informed the senior police officials about the outcome of the said application. He further submits that further investigation qua accused Manoj Pradhan is still

pending and his address is already available with him. He further submits that FSL result is also pending. He further submits that he will file supplementary charge-sheet as and when further investigation qua accused Manoj Pradhan and FSL result is complete.

I take cognizance of the offence.

Copy of charge sheet has been supplied to the present accused persons against acknowledgment.

Issue notice to the IO to appear in person with report regarding FSL result and supplementary charge-sheet, returnable on 04.11.2025.

At the request of Ld. counsel, date is changed to **10.11.2025**. The date i.e. 04.11.2025 stands cancelled.
