Present: Mustafa, brother of accused-applicant Danish (in bail application no.198/18).

Sh.Wasi-Ur-Rehman, Addl. PP for the State.

Advocates are stated to be on strike. Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and Hon'ble High Court have disapproved the practice of the lawyers proceeding on strike.

It was for Counsel for the accused to appear and argue the bail application but despite wait, Counsel for applicant has not come present to argue the application.

Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor has advanced arguments.

This is third bail application of the accused-applicant Danish as finds mention in the application itself. Vide order dated 03.04.2018 for the reasons given in detail, Court dismissed bail application of accused-applicant Danish.

It is true that after 06.12.2017 PW Sunil Das and Chotey Lal have been examined as PW8 and PW10 respectively but Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor submits that PWs Ajay, Rahul and Vinod, who are injured and Suraj, an eye witness, are also to be examined.

Case is coming up for prosecution evidence on

28.08.2018 and thereafter, on 13.09.2017⁸ for recording of statement of PW Suraj.

As regards release of bail of co-accused Tarush, he was allowed bail by the Hon'ble High Court.

As regards release on bail of Himanshu accused, this very ground has already been dealt with by this court vide order dated 03.04.2018.

No other fresh ground has been put forth in the application. Having regard to all the facts and circumstances and for the reasons recorded in detail in order dated 06.12.2017 and 03.04.2018, Court does not find any ground to release accused-applicant Danish on bail. Bail Application No.198/18 is hereby dismissed.
