State v. Amit Nayak etc.

Present: Counsel for accused-applicant Amit Nayak **(in bail application no.223/18).**

Learned Counsel for accused-applicant submits that accused-applicant has been facing trial for an offence u/s 326 read with section 149 IPC; that accused Montu, Danish and Tarush have already been granted bail by Hon'ble High Court and as such, accused-applicant be also allowed bail.

Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor submits that some of the victims are yet to be examined and as such accused-applicant be not allowed bail.

Undisputedly, accused Montu, Danish and Tarush have already been allowed bail by the Hon'ble High Court. On the ground of parity, accused-applicant also deserves to be allowed bail.

Accordingly, accused-applicant Amit Nayak is allowed bail on furnishing a personal bond of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to the condition that the applicant shall not do anything which may prejudice the prosecution witnesses. The applicant shall not make any endeavour to contact the complainant or any of the

prosecution witnesses. The applicant shall not leave the country without permission of court.

Bail Application No.223/18 is hereby disposed of.
