State Vs. Amit Nayak @ Bharat & Ors.**

Matter is taken up today for hearing through videoconferencing in terms of directions passed under the order No. 896/RG/DHC/2021 dated 30.12.2021.

Present: Sh. K.P. Singh, Ld Addl. PP for State, through videoconferencing.

Accused Amit Nayak on bail, present through videoconferencing.

Accused Montu, Danish, Tarush, Prince and Prakash on bail, are absent.

Sh. P. K. Garg, Ld.Counsel for accused Amit Nayak through videoconferencing.

Sh. Kamal Deep, Ld.Counsel for accused Himanshu and Amit Sharma through videoconferencing.

Ld. Counsel for accused Prakash submits that accused Prakash is produced from J/C as though he is on regular bail but is running in custody in connection with another criminal case. **Let production warrants be issued for production of accused Prakash for his appearance in court for 10.02.2022.**

Ld. Counsel for accused Amit Sharma submits that accused Amit Sharma is unable to appear today due to medical emergency and that he shall file appropriate application for personal exemption of accused Amit Sharma, during the course of the day.

Ld.Counsel for accused Himanshu submits that accused Himanshu is unable to connect webex hearing as he is not well conversant with the process and it appears that he may be facing some connectivity issues.

NBWs issued for arrest and production of accused Amit Nayak as well as of his surety, received with the report that accused Amit Nayak as well as his surety, are no longer residing at the given address.

An application is filed on behalf of accused Amit Nayak for cancellation of NBWs.

Ld.Counsel submits that accused/applicant in order to attend the wedding in the family with his parents, was out of station and that is why he could not appear on the date fixed for hearing. Ld.Counsel undertakes that accused shall furnish his present address on affidavit, in the course of the day.

Taking into consideration the explanation tendered by accused and as the accused has appeared of his own, bonds are restored, however, subject to penalty amount of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited within two days.
