Longer date given because this is designated court for cases under NDPS Act and as per the directions issued by Hon'ble Apex Court in case "**Thana Singh Vs. Central Bureau of Narcotics**", (2013) 2 Supreme Court Cases 590, all cases other than the cases under NDPS Act are to be taken up after the cases under NDPS are cleared and priority is to be given to the cases under NDPS Act, but many murder & other session cases are pending for evidence.
