**Bail Application for grant of regular bail.**

**ORDER**

This order of mine shall dispose off bail application filed by accused/applicant for grant of regular bail.

2. Counsel for the accused/applicant submitted that accused/applicant has been falsely implicated in this case. He has not committed any offence. He further submitted that no recovery was effected from the conscious possession of the accused/applicant. He further submitted that accused/applicant went to Barnala to meet his brother in law and when he was coming back, he took the lift from

Barnala to Patran but no recovery was effected from him. So, he be released on bail.

3. On the other hand, APP for the State opposed the bail application on the ground that accused/applicant was in car alongwith other co-accused and when at T-point of village Duggan, their car was searched and 400 gram heroin was recovered from the gear lever of the car. So, recovery is under commercial quantity and he is not entitled for bail. So, bail application be dismissed.

4. After hearing the arguments of learned APP for the State and learned counsel for the accused, I have perused the police file.

5. The allegations against accused are on 22.03.2024, SI Avtar Singh alongwith the police party in search of bad elements was going from Kunran to Sangrur via Barnala-Sangrur main road then at about 4:30 PM, when they reached at T-point Duggan, a car bearing no. HR-29-A1-4877 was parked and two gentlemen were sitting in the car who on seeing the car of police party, became perplexed and tried to run away but they were apprehended with the help of police party. The person who was driving the car disclosed his name as Gurraj Singh alias Happy and person sitting on the conductor seat disclosed his name as Rghubir Singh alias Samma. Car was searched and one polythene was recovered from the gear lever of the car and it was found 400 gram heroin. Since the recovery effected from the accused is under commercial quantity. So, he is not entitled for bail. Accordingly, bail application is dismissed. However, it is made clear that observation made herein above shall not be construed as

an expression on the merits of main case. The bail application files be attached with the remand papers.
