Defendant is yet to be summoned.

1. From the record it is evident that an application moved on behalf of the plaintiff under Order VI Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC is pending for disposal.
2. Perusal of the aforesaid application would reveal that similar application had been moved on behalf of the plaintiff which was allowed by the Ld. Predecessor of this Court vide order dated 04.05.2026.
3. Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff submits that the amended plaint was not signed on behalf of the plaintiff and that is why she has moved the present application.
4. Heard and perused the record.
5. Non-signing of the each of the pages of the plaint is a curable defect. The defendant is yet to be summoned. It appears that the plaintiff has not filed the statement of truth along with the amended plaint. Therefore, the plaintiff is directed to file the statement of truth by the next date of hearing subject to which the amended plaint is taken on record. The instant application of the plaintiff moved under Order VI Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC is **disposed off** accordingly.
