Today is fixed for hearing of the application u/s 13B of Hindu Marriage Act.

Both petitioner No.1 and petitioner No. 2 are present through their Ld. Advocate by filing haziras.

Petitioner No. 1, **Smt Sriparna Sen** and petitioner No. 2, **Sri Subhamoy Nag** filed their respective affidavit in chief. They are examined on dock as P.W. 1 and 2 respectively. During their examination-in-chief they have confirmed their affidavit-in-chief to be true. Petitioner No. 1 files attested xerox copy of her Aadhar card which has been marked as **Exhibit-1** and petitioner No. 2 files attested xerox copy of his Aadhar Card which has been marked as **Exhibit-A**.

Heard both sides.

The record is taken up for passing necessary order.

Hearing arose from the petition under section **13B of the Hindu Marriage Act 1955** filed on **09.02.26**. Thereafter on expiry of six months petitioner No. 1 and petitioner No. 2 are examined on **12.08.26** on oath.

It appears from petition u/s 13B of Hindu Marriage Act that their marriage was solemnized on **17.11.24** as per Hindu rites and customs and after marriage they lived together as husband and wife at the house of petitioner No. 2. It also appears that due to difference of opinion, habit and culture they have been residing separately since **22.01.25**.

From this wedlock there is no issue.

From the evidence of the parties, it reveals that there is no chance of reunion and parties have amicably settled to dissolve their marriage tie by way of mutual divorce. There is no legal impediment for granting the prayer. Petition is not collusive one.

The marriage tie between Petitioner No. 1, **Smt Sriparna Sen** and petitioner No. 2, **Sri Subhamoy Nag** is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce on mutual consent under section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.
