Today case is fixed for cross examination of DW1.

An application filed by defendant u/o XVI Rule 1(2) r/w
Section 151 CPC for summoning of witnesses is pending for disposal.

Arguments heard.

Ld. Counsel for defendant submits that he wants to
examine three witnesses i.e. Sh. Deepak Kumar, Mrs. Amrita Wahi &
Dr. A.K Gupta, whose details have been mentioned in para-2 of
application, to prove his defence.

Ld. Counsel for plaintiff has no objection.

Hence, I allow the application.

Let summoned be issued to aforesaid witnesses subject
to deposit of diet money of Rs. 2,500/- each for witnesses no. (a) & (c)
and diet money of Rs. 1,000/- for witness no. (c) for 06.12.2024.

As far as cross examination of DW1 is concerned, Ld.
Counsel for defendant submits that DW1 is having spine problem and
doctor has advised him to take rest. Copy of prescription has also been
filed.

In these circumstances, case is adjourned for cross
examination of DW1 on **02.12.2024**, remaining DE on **06.12.2024** and
for final arguments on **16.12.2024**.
