Vajid & oths. V/s State

ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN CRIM.BAIL APPL.NO.65/2026
(CNR No.MHOS-16-000235-2026)

01. The accused Nos. 1) **Vajid Innus Inamdar, age 41 years,** 2) **Javed Innus Inamdar, age 41 years,** 3) **Arif Yusuf Inamdar, age 40 years** are seeking regular bail U/sec. 483 of BNSS in Crime No.240/2026 registered before Yermala Police-station for an offences punishable U/sec.119(1),118(1),115(2),189(2),191(2), 190,333,324(2),352,351(2) of the B.N.S.2023 and offences p/u/sec. 3(1)(r),3(1)(s),3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

02. Perused bail application, say of I.O./Ld.A.P.P, copy of FIR and investigation papers. Heard Ld. Adv.M.N.Kasar appearing on behalf of applicant and Ld. A.P.P. Shri. A.P.Kulkarni for State and informant at length.

03. On perusal of FIR, it appears that the informant Akash Suresh Shinde lodged complaint before Yermala police station on 04.06.2026 alleging therein he resides at Yermala along with his mother, wife and sister. On 01.06.2026 at about 10.00 pm he was cultivating his land with the help of JCB, at that time his neighbors Wahid Fakir, Javed Fakir, Ganni Fakir, Yusuf Fakir, Jappu Fakir and Lalya Fakir all r/o Yermala, Tq.Kallam entered into his field and they told "This land belongs to them, why you are breaking the common bandh". At that time they told and used

word “Pardhadano” and abused him in filthy language. They also restrained to the driver of JCB, then his sister Shital was also abused by these persons in filthy language. They also thrown blue coloured flags from his field. Then he had been to police station but after discussion matter was settled.

04. Further he stated on 02.06.2026 at about 2.00 am. he along with his sister were slept in their house, after hearing sound of dog he came out of his house. At that time these above persons were present in front of his house. They abused to him. Wahid Fakir, Javed Fakir assaulted to his sister by means of kick and hand blow on her abdomen and they assaulted to her on her left hand by means of iron road. Then she shouted loudly, then these persons proceeded further and threatened to kill informant and her sister. At that time accused persons snatched ear ring of Rs.20,000/- and therefore he had been to police station and lodged complaint.

05. It is the contention of present accused persons that they have not committed any offence as alleged by informant. They arrested on 17.06.2026 and after sufficient PCR they are taken in to MCR on 19.06.2026 and since then they are in jail. So, it is their contention mostly investigation is completed, therefore they prayed they be released on bail.

06. I.O./Ld. A.P.P. and informant filed their say stating

therein that accused persons committed serious offence against the informant and his sister. Investigation is in progress, if they released on bail again they will commit serious offence against informant. Therefore it is prayed for rejection of bail.

07. However, on perusal of FIR, it appears that words used on caste of informant as per FIR is dated 01.06.2026. Then they had been to police station and their matter was settled. Then another incident is of dated 02.06.2026 in mid night. So, informant have not specifically stated who used word on his caste. Not only this specific name of any accused persons is not mentioned in his complaint who humiliated to the informant on his caste within public view. Not only this it is also not specifically mentioned in the FIR the role of each accused. Further it appears that, present accused persons are arrested on 17.06.2026 and after sufficient PCR they are taken into MCR on 19.06.2026 and since then they are in jail. Mostly investigation is completed. There is no justifiable reason to refuse the bail. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

- 1) Bail application is hereby allowed.
- 2) Accused nos. 1) **Vajid Innus Inamdar, age 41 years**, 2) **Javed Innus Inamdar, age 41 years**, 3) **Arif Yusuf Inamdar, age 40 years** arrested in Crime No.240/2026 registered at Yermala Police

Station for the offences punishable U/sec.119(1),118(1),115(2), 189(2),191(2),190,333,324(2),352,351(2) of the B.N.S.2023, offences pun.u/sec. 3(1)(r),3(1)(s),3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act be released on bail on furnishing P.R. Bond of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety in the like amount subject to following conditions -

- a. Accused shall not commit any offence or indulge in any criminal activity.
- b. They shall not tamper the prosecution evidence and shall not pressurize the prosecution witnesses.
- c. They shall attend concerned Police Station on every Friday from 10.00AM to 2.00PM till filing of charge-sheet.
- d. They shall submit at least two relative's address proof and current phone numbers.
- e. They shall submit copies of at least one documents i.e. Pancard, Aadhar Card, Bank Passbook, Voter Id Card and Driving Licence.

3) As the applicants are in jail, the soft copy of this order be e-mailed to the Superintendent of Jail at the earliest.
