1. Received a copy of judgment and order passed by Hon'ble High Court of Tripura in Cont.Cas(C) No.63 of 2025 dated 03.07.2026.
2. Perused the same.
3. Keep the same with the case record.
4. The operative portion of the said order runs as follows:

“In the result, the petition filed by the petitioner-defacto-complainant is hereby allowed. The respondent-contemnors are found to be guilty of the contempt of Court's order under section 12 of the Contempt of

Courts Act, 1971 and they are sentenced to fine of Rs.2000/- each in default they should undergo SI for one month each. The respondent-contemnors namely Pradip Nama alias Gontu, Jogeswar Das, Bishu Ranjan Das, Babul Chandra Das alias Babul, Pinku Poddar and Manoranjan Tripura alias Mona are further directed to deposit the fine money to the Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee within a period of 15 days from the date of passing of this judgment and to submit an affidavit in the is regard before this court.”

5. Accused persons namely Pradip Nama alias Gontu, Jogeshwar Das, Bishu Ranjan Das, Babul Chandra Das alias Hotel Babul, Pinku Poddar, Manoranjan Tripura alias Mona are also produced today in the case before this court from J/C.

6. Ld. Addl. PP Mr. Chanchal Biswas representing the State is present.

7. Ld. Defence Counsel Mr. S.

Majumder for accused Sri Pinku Poddar filed an application that accused was convicted by the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura in connection with the case No.Cont.Cas(C) No.63 of 2025 and was sentenced to a fine of Rs.2000/- in default to undergo SI for one month. However, as accused is unable to pay said fine amount of money, so he is ready to suffer SI for one month.

8. Ld. Defence Counsel Mr. A.H. Majumder for accused persons namely Jogeshwar Das, Bishu Ranjan Das, Babul Chandra Das alias Hotel Babul is also present and submitted that the accused persons were convicted by the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura in connection with the case No.Cont.Cas(C) No.63 of 2025 and were sentenced to a fine of Rs.2000/- in default to undergo SI for one month. However, as accused persons are unable to pay said fine amount of money, so they are ready to suffer

SI for one month.

9. Ld. Defence Counsel Mr. Bappa Pal for accused persons namely Manoranjan Tripura alias Mona and Pradip Nama alias Gontu is also present and submitted that the accused persons were convicted by the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura in connection with the case No.Cont.Cas(C) No.63 of 2025 and were sentenced to a fine of Rs.2000/- in default to undergo SI for one month. However, as accused persons are unable to pay said fine amount of money, so they are ready to suffer SI for one month.

10. As the case bearing No. Cont.Cas(C) No.63 of 2025 is the exclusive case of the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura and the judgment and order was also passed exclusively by the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura, and as no any specific direction is made to this court in respect of dealing in the matter of the conviction of the accused to a fine of Rs.2000/- in default to undergo

SI for one month, so the matter is exclusively the matter of Hon'ble High Court of Tripura.

11. The accused persons are to approach and make necessary step and communication through their engaged Ld. Counsels before the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura in connection with the inability to pay the fine money of Rs.2000/- imposed upon them and in default to undergo SI for one month in connection with case No. Cont.Cas(C) No.63 of 2025, as the said case is independent and distinct separate case from the present case, which has its own legal form and implication.

12. As no bail application has been filed for and on behalf of the accused persons, so the accused persons are again remanded to J/C till 31.07.2026.

13. As the original case record has already been send back and received by this court and as there has been still other

prosecution witnesses still yet to be examined and cross-examined, so, issue fresh summons upon the un-examined prosecution witnesses in the following calenders:
