1. Reply filed. Copy supplied.
2. This is an application filed on behalf of the applicant/accused Vikas (hereinafter referred to as applicant) for grant of regular bail.
3. It is argued that the applicant is in J.C. since 18.10.2024. It is further argued that the applicant has been falsely implicated in this case and the allegations against him are false. It is further argued that there is undue and unexplained delay in lodging the FIR. It is further argued that the applicant has no past criminal antecedents and the applicant is the local resident of Delhi. It is further argued that the charge-sheet has been filed in this case. It is further argued that the applicant's mother is totally

dependent upon the applicant for food, medicines and livelihood who is 60 years old. It is further argued that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the applicant. It is further argued that the co-accused Guddu is already on bail. Ld. Counsel for applicant has relied upon the judgment in case titled as *Manish Sisodia vs. ED*, 2024 SCC OnLine SC 1920 to support his arguments. It is prayed that the applicant be released on bail.

4. Application has been opposed by the ld. Addl. PP for State on the ground that the allegations against the applicant are serious in nature. It is further submitted that the knife used in the offence has been recovered. It is further submitted that all the accused persons and complainant live in the same premises and he may commit the similar offence, again if released on bail. It is further submitted that the applicant brought the knife and gave it to co-accused Shubham Kushwaha. It is prayed that bail application of the applicant may be dismissed.
5. Arguments heard. Record perused.
6. The allegations against the applicant are that he alongwith his associates in furtherance of their common intention attempted to cause murder of the complainant. The role of the applicant in the incident was that he gave beatings to the complainant and one Nikhil by legs and fists and he was the one who brought knife to the spot and handed it over to the co-accused Shubham who inflicted the injuries upon the person of the complainant and Nikhil.

7. The applicant has been specifically named in the FIR and his role is almost clear as alleged by the complainant in the FIR.
8. The allegations are of grave and serious nature.
9. Considering the overall facts and circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the applicant at this stage.
10. Application filed by the applicant for grant of bail is hereby dismissed.
11. Copy of this order be given dasti to Id. Counsel for applicant/accused.
12. A hard as well as soft copy be also sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent immediately for information and necessary action.
