1. From the record it is evident that one application moved under Order XI Rule 5 CPC by the plaintiff is pending for disposal, whereby a request has been made to take a document on record and to give the exhibit mark as **Ex.PW1/1**.
2. Ld. Counsel for the defendant submits that he does not want to file any reply to the aforesaid application and he has no objection in case the prayers made by the said application are allowed.
3. Heard and perused the record.
4. Vide instant application, the plaintiff has made a request to permit the plaintiff to place on record the complete document in respect of the registration of the plaintiff firm; it is stated that along with the plaint, the document pertaining to the registration of the plaintiff firm was filed but inadvertently, one page could not be filed under the impression that it was not part and parcel of the

registration document of the plaintiff firm. It is was further stated that the said registration certificate was given **Ex.PW1/1**, which was incomplete and now the plaintiff wants to make the deficiency good by adding the said page.

5. In view of the submissions made and the fact that Ld. Counsel for the defendant has given no objection, the instant application moved on behalf of the plaintiff is allowed, whereby the document in question is taken on record. However, the plaintiff is burdened with a cost of Rs.5,000/- to be paid by the plaintiff to the defendant as unnecessary the precious time of the court has been wasted. The said document shall be read into evidence as part and parcel of the document already exhibited as **Ex.PW1/1**. The present application is **disposed off** accordingly.
6. Ld. Counsel for the defendant submits that he is not feeling well and he is not in a position to cross examine PW1 today. Seeks adjournment. Not opposed.
7. Now file be taken up for cross examination of PW1 on **30.01.2026 at 2:00 PM**.
8. Date and time has been given absolutely as per the convenience of Ld. Counsels for both the parties.
